Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for:
NISSAN TRADE Bus 3.0 TDiC

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: RENAULT MASTER II Box (FD) 2.2 dCI 90

REPLACEMENT: HEADLIGHT BULBS – NISSAN TRADE MINIBUS. TOOLS YOU NEED:



- Electronic spray

- Fender cover

Replacement: headlight bulbs – NISSAN Trade Minibus. Professionals recommend:

- The procedure for replacing the bulbs in the right and left headlights is identical.
- Replace the bulbs in both headlights at the same time.
- All the work should be carried out with the ignition switched off.

REPLACEMENT: HEADLIGHT BULBS – NISSAN TRADE MINIBUS. TAKE THE FOLLOWING STEPS:

1 Open the bonnet.

2 Use a fender protection cover to avoid damaging the paintwork and plastic parts of the car.

3 Remove the headlight rear cover.



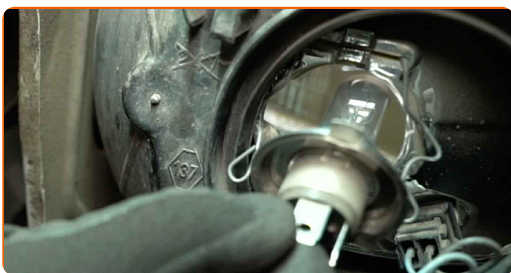
4 Detach the connector of the low and high beam bulb.



- 5 Pull aside the retainers of the low and high beam bulb.



- 6 Remove the low and high beam bulb.



- 7 Install a new low and high beam bulb into its mounting seat.



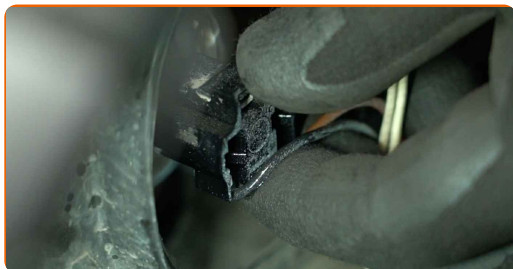
- 8 Secure the low and high beam bulb with the retainers.



- 9 Treat the low and high beam bulb connector. Use an electronic spray.



10 Attach the connector of the low and high beam bulb.



11 Install the headlight rear cover.



12 Remove the fender cover.

13 Close the bonnet.

14 Check that the new component is working.
