This replacement procedure can be used for:

OPEL Astra Classic Saloon (A04) 1.7 CDTi, OPEL Astra Classic Saloon (A04) 1.6,

OPEL Astra Classic Saloon (A04) 1.7 CDTI, OPEL Astra Classic Saloon (A04) 1.8 (L69)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.



REPLACEMENT: TAILGATE STRUTS - OPEL ASTRA CLASSIC SALOON (A04). TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



WD-40 spray

Flat screwdriver

Buy tools

Replacement: tailgate struts – OPEL Astra Classic Saloon (A04). Tip from AUTODOC:

- Right and left gas struts of the boot lid should be replaced simultaneously.
- The replacement procedure is identical for the right and left gas struts of the boot lid.
- Please note: all work on the car OPEL Astra Classic Saloon (A04) should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

- Open the boot lid.
- Release the circlip connecting the gas strut to the boot lid. Use a flat screwdriver.

Close the lid of the luggage compartment. 16



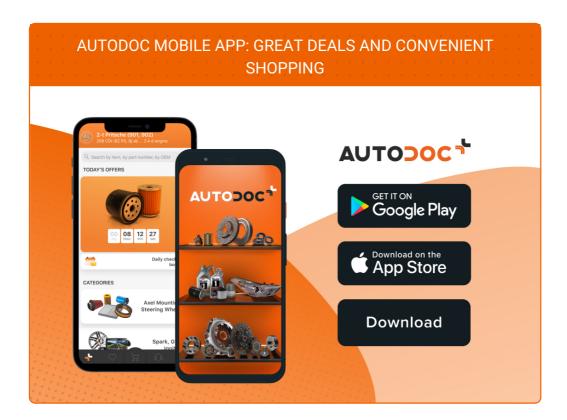
