OPEL Vivaro A Van (X83) 1.9 DI (F7), OPEL Vivaro A Van (X83) 1.9 DTI (F7), OPEL Vivaro A Van (X83) 2.0 16V (F7), OPEL Vivaro A Van (X83) 2.5 DTI (F7), OPEL Vivaro A Van (X83) 2.0 ECOTEC (F7), OPEL Vivaro A Van (X83) 2.5 CDTI (F7)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.



REPLACEMENT: THIRD BRAKE LIGHT – OPEL VIVARO A VAN (X83). TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Electronic spray
- 8 mm socket
- 10 mm socket
- Ratchet wrench
- Masking tape

- Plastic trim removal tool
- Slotted screwdriver
- Clip removal tool
- Transmission jack
- Wide wooden block

Replacement: third brake light – OPEL Vivaro A Van (X83). AUTODOC recommends:

• All the work should be carried out with the ignition switched off.

REPLACEMENT: THIRD BRAKE LIGHT – OPEL VIVARO A VAN (X83). USE THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE:

Secure the third brake light. Use masking tape.



Open the rear door.

Unscrew the fastener of the third brake light. Use an 8 mm socket. Use a ratchet wrench.

- Close the rear door.
- Remove the masking tape.



Remove the third brake light. Use a plastic trim removal tool.



Detach the connector from the third brake light.



Replacement: third brake light – OPEL Vivaro A Van (X83). AUTODOC experts recommend:

• If necessary, use a slotted screwdriver to release the connector.

Treat the third brake light connector. Use an electronic spray.



Install the bulb in the new third brake light.



Attach the connector to the new third brake light.



11 Install the new third brake light.



Secure the third brake light. Use masking tape.

- Screw on the fastener of the third brake light. Use an 8 mm socket. Use a ratchet wrench.



- Close the rear door.
- 16 Remove the masking tape.
- Check that the new component is working.
