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How to change front lower arm on **Peugeot**107 PM PN –

replacement guide

This replacement procedure can be used for: PEUGEOT 107 Hatchback (PM, PN) 1.4 HDi

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

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REPLACEMENT: FRONT LOWER ARM – PEUGEOT 107 PM PN. TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Brake cleaner
- Copper grease
- Combination spanner #10
- Combination spanner #19
- Drive socket # 12
- Drive socket # 17

- Wheel impact socket #17
- Ratchet wrench
- Torque wrench
- Tap wrench
- Crow bar
- Ball joint puller
- Hydraulic transmission jack
- Wheel chock

BUY TOOLS

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Replacement: front lower arm – Peugeot 107 PM PN. AUTODOC experts recommend:

- The replacement procedure is identical for the left and right lower control arms.
- Warning! Shut down the engine before starting any work Peugeot 107 PM PN.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

1

Secure the wheels with chocks.



Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



Raise the front of the car and secure on supports.



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4 Unscrew the wheel bolts.



Replacement: front lower arm – Peugeot 107 PM PN. Tip:

• To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when unscrewing the bolts.

Remove the wheel.

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Clean the stabiliser link fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



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Unscrew the fastener connecting the stabilizer bar with the control arm. Use a combination spanner #10. Use a drive socket #12. Use a ratchet wrench.



Remove the stabilizer rod. Use a crowbar.



Remove the cotter pin. Use a crowbar.

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Clean the fastener connecting the ball joint to the steering knuckle. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



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Unscrew the ball joint fastening to the steering knuckle. Use a combination spanner #19.



Disconnect the lower arm from the steering knuckle. Use a ball joint puller.



Clean all joints of the arm. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: front lower arm – Peugeot 107 PM PN. After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

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Unscrew the front arm fastener. Use a drive socket #17. Use a tap wrench.



Remove the front fastener of the control arm. Use a drive socket #17.



Unscrew the rear fastener connecting the control arm to the subframe. Use a drive socket #17. Use a tap wrench.



17 Remove the rear fastener of the control arm. Use a drive socket #17.



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18 Remove the arm. Use a crowbar.



Clean the mounting seats and the thread of the suspension arm. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



20 Install a new arm.



Replacement: front lower arm – Peugeot 107 PM PN. AUTODOC recommends:

- During the installation process, use only new bolts and nuts.
- Do not damage the ball joint cover.

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Install the control arm fasteners. Use a drive socket #17.



Connect the lower arm to the steering knuckle.



23 Install the transverse stabilizer link.



Screw in the fastener connecting the stabilizer bar to the control arm. Use a combination spanner #10. Use a drive socket #12. Use a ratchet wrench.



Support the arm. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.

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Screw the fastener connecting the ball joint to the steering knuckle. Use a combination spanner #19.



Tighten the rear fastener of the control arm. Use a drive socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 100 Nm torque.



Tighten the front fastener connecting the control arm to the subframe. Use a drive socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 116 Nm torque.



Tighten the ball joint fastener. Use a combination spanner #19. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 98 nm torque.



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Install the cotter pin. Use a crowbar.



Remove the support from under the arm.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: front lower arm Peugeot 107 PM PN. Lower the transmission jack smoothly, without jerks, to avoid damaging components and mechanisms.
- Tighten the fastener connecting the stabilizer bar with the control arm. Use a drive socket #12. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 18 Nm torque.



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Treat all joints of the arm. Use copper grease.



Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use copper grease.



Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.



Replacement: front lower arm – Peugeot 107 PM PN. Professionals recommend:

• After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

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Install the wheel.



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AUTODOC recommends:

 Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts on the car. Peugeot 107 PM PN





Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 100 nm torque.



Remove the jacks and chocks.






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
