How to change serpentine belt on PEUGEOT 206
Hatchback (2A/C) – replacement guide

This video shows the replacement procedure of a similar car part on another vehicle

(i) Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for:

PEUGEOT 206 Hatchback (2A/C) 1.1 i, PEUGEOT 206 Hatchback (2A/C) 1.4 i, PEUGEOT 206 Hatchback (2A/C) 1.6 i, PEUGEOT 206 Hatchback (2A/C) 1.4 LPG, PEUGEOT 206 Hatchback (2A/C) 1.6 16V, PEUGEOT 206 Hatchback (2A/C) 1.1, PEUGEOT 206 Hatchback (2A/C) 1.6, PEUGEOT 206 Hatchback (2A/C) 1.6 8V

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

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REPLACEMENT: SERPENTINE BELT – PEUGEOT 206 HATCHBACK (2A/C). LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



• Square oil drain plug socket No.3/8"

Fender cover

Buy tools

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Replacement: serpentine belt – PEUGEOT 206 Hatchback (2A/C). AUTODOC recommends:

• All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: SERPENTINE BELT – PEUGEOT 206 HATCHBACK (2A/C). RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:

- Open the hood.
- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Lift the car using a jack or place it over an inspection pit.
- Pull aside the V-ribbed belt tensioner pulley. Use square oil drain plug socket No.3/8"



Remove the V-ribbed belt. Return the tensioner pulley to its initial position.



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Replacement: serpentine belt – PEUGEOT 206 Hatchback (2A/C). AUTODOC experts recommend:

 Check the condition of the tensioner pulley and idler pulley. Replace them if necessary.

6 Install the V-ribbed belt.



Replacement: serpentine belt – PEUGEOT 206 Hatchback (2A/C). Tip:

- Make sure that the V-ribbed belt fits all pulleys snugly.
- Pull aside the V-ribbed belt tensioner pulley. Use square oil drain plug socket No.3/8"



Place the V-ribbed belt on the tensioner pulley.

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9 Return the tensioner pulley to its initial position.



- Run the engine for a few minutes. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.
 - Lower the car.
- Remove the fender protection cover.
- Close the hood.



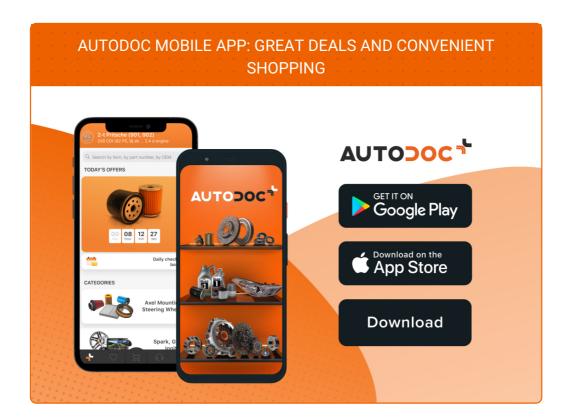
