PEUGEOT 3008 II Off-Road (M_) 2.0 BlueHDi 180, PEUGEOT 3008 II Off-Road (M_) 1.6 BlueHDi 120, PEUGEOT 3008 II Off-Road (M_) 2.0 BlueHDi 150, PEUGEOT 3008 II Off-Road (M_) 1.6 THP 165, PEUGEOT 3008 II Off-Road (M_) 1.2, PEUGEOT 3008 II Off-Road (M_) 1.6 BlueHDi 100, PEUGEOT 3008 II Off-Road (M_) 1.6 BlueHDi 115, PEUGEOT 3008 II Off-Road (M_) 2.0 BlueHDi 136, PEUGEOT 3008 II Off-Road (M_) 1.5 BlueHDi 130, PEUGEOT 3008 II Off-Road (M_) 1.6 PureTech 180, PEUGEOT 3008 II Off-Road (M_) Hybrid, PEUGEOT 3008 II Off-Road (M_) Hybrid4 (M45GBU), PEUGEOT 3008 II Off-Road (M_) Hybrid4

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

REPLACEMENT: ANTI ROLL BAR LINKS – PEUGEOT
3008 II OFF-ROAD (M_). TOOLS YOU NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Brake cleaner
- Copper grease
- Combination spanner #16
- Drive socket # 15
- Drive socket # 17
- Wheel impact socket #17
- Ratchet wrench
- Wheel chock

Buy tools

Replacement: anti roll bar links – PEUGEOT 3008 II Off-Road (M_). AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Replace the stabiliser links on PEUGEOT 3008 II Off-Road (M_) in pairs.
- The replacement procedure is identical for both stabiliser links on the same axle.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: ANTI ROLL BAR LINKS – PEUGEOT 3008 II OFF-ROAD (M_). RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:

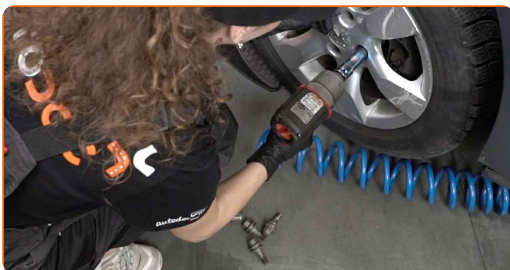
1 Secure the wheels with chocks.

2 Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



3 Raise the front of the car and secure on supports.

4 Unscrew the wheel bolts.



Replacement: anti roll bar links – PEUGEOT 3008 II Off-Road (M_). AUTODOC recommends:

- To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when unscrewing the bolts.

Remove the wheel.

Remove the ABS wiring harness bracket.

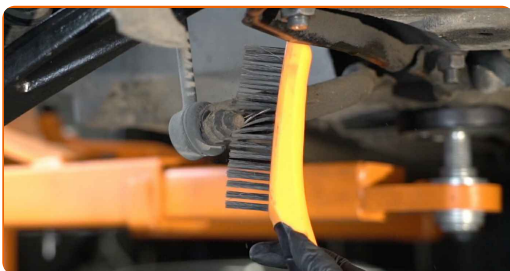
Clean the stabiliser link fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



- 8 Unscrew the fastener connecting the stabilizer link to the shock strut. Use a drive socket #15. Use a ratchet wrench.



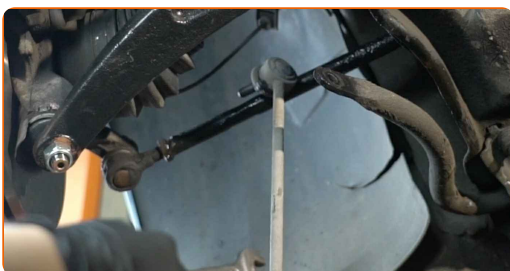
- 9 Clean the stabiliser link fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



- 10 Unscrew the fastener connecting the stabilizer link to the stabilizer bar. Use a combination spanner #16. Use a drive socket #15. Use a ratchet wrench.



- 11 Remove the stabilizer rod.



Replacement: anti roll bar links – PEUGEOT 3008 II Off-Road (M_). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Examine stabiliser bushes. Replace them if needed.

Clean the mounting seats of the stabiliser link. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.

Install a new rod, tighten the fasteners.

Tighten the fastener connecting the stabilizer link to the stabilizer bar. Use a drive socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 36 Nm torque.



- 15** Tighten the fastener connecting the stabilizer link to the shock strut. Use a drive socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 36 Nm torque.



- 16** Treat all joints of the stabiliser link. Use copper grease.



- 17** Install the ABS wiring harness bracket.



- 18** Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use copper grease.

Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: anti roll bar links – PEUGEOT 3008 II Off-Road (M_). After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

Install the wheel.



Replacement: anti roll bar links – PEUGEOT 3008 II Off-Road (M_). Tip from AUTODOC:

- To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when screwing in the fastening bolts.

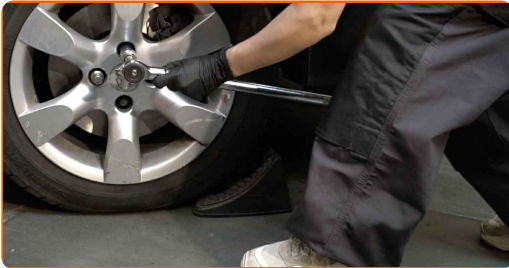

Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.

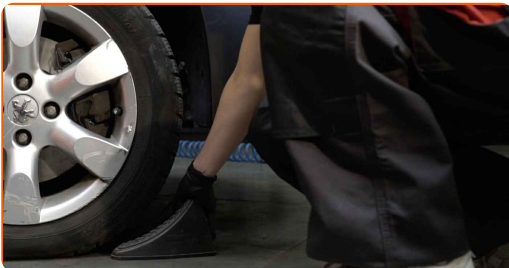

Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 100 nm torque.

Remove the jacks and chocks.
