This replacement procedure can be used for:

PEUGEOT 308 II Hatchback 1.6, PEUGEOT 308 II Hatchback 1.6 THP 125, PEUGEOT 308 II Hatchback 1.6 GT 205, PEUGEOT 308 II Hatchback 1.6 THP 150, PEUGEOT 308 II Hatchback 1.6 THP 163, PEUGEOT 308 II Hatchback 1.6 GTi, PEUGEOT 308 II Hatchback 1.6 PureTech 225, PEUGEOT 308 II Hatchback 1.6 GTi PureTech

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

REPLACEMENT: IGNITION COIL - PEUGEOT 308 II HATCHBACK. LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Electronic spray
- Flat screwdriver

- Fender cover
- Ignition coil removal tool

Replacement: ignition coil - PEUGEOT 308 II Hatchback. AUTODOC recommends:

- The replacement procedure is the same for the ignition coils of all cylinders.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: IGNITION COIL - PEUGEOT 308 II HATCHBACK. **RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:**

- Open the hood.
- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Unplug the connectors from the ignition coils.



Detach the connector from the ignition coil.

Pry up the ignition coil. Use an ignition coil remover. Take out the ignition coil from the spark plug well.



6 Clean dirt, dust and debris from inside the spark plug well.



Install the new ignition coil to the spark plug well. Make sure you hear a click indicating that it is locked in place.



Treat the ignition coil connector with electronic spray. The spray will protect the electrical contacts from corrosion, oxidation, and will reduce the contact resistance.

Plug in the connectors of the ignition coils.



Lock the connector.



- Remove the fender protection cover.
- Close the hood.
