

How to change rear coil springs on **Nissan Qashqai J10** – replacement guide

(i) Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for: NISSAN Qashqai / Qashqai+2 I (J10, NJ10) 1.6, NISSAN Qashqai / Qashqai+2 I (J10, NJ10) 1.5 dCi

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.





REPLACEMENT: COIL SPRINGS – NISSAN QASHQAI J10. TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Copper grease
- Torque wrench
- Combination spanner #18
- Drive socket # 18
- Wheel impact socket #21

- Ratchet wrench
- Tap wrench
- Crow bar
- Strut spring compressor
- Hydraulic transmission jack
- Wheel chock

Replacement: coil springs - Nissan Qashqai J10. Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Both coil springs of the rear suspension should be replaced simultaneously.
- The replacement procedure is identical for the left and right coil springs of the rear suspension.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: COIL SPRINGS – NISSAN QASHQAI J10. TAKE THE FOLLOWING STEPS:



Secure the wheels with chocks.

Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #21.

Raise the rear of the car and secure on supports.







Unscrew the wheel bolts.



AUTODOC recommends:

• To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when unscrewing the bolts.



Remove the wheel.

Support the arm. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.

Clean the shock absorber fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.

Unscrew the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a combination spanner #18. Use a drive socket #18. Use a ratchet wrench.



Replacement: coil springs - Nissan Qashqai J10. Professionals recommend:

• To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when unscrewing the bolts.



Remove the shock absorber.



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Remove the support from under the rear arm.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Nissan Qashqai J10 – Do not lower the transmission jack sharply to avoid damaging components and mechanisms of the car.





Unscrew the stabilizer rod fasteners. Use a combination spanner #18. Use a drive socket #18. Use a ratchet wrench.



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Install the coil spring compressor on the coil spring.



Replacement: coil springs – Nissan Qashqai J10. Tip from AUTODOC:

- Use adapters and jaws of the appropriate size.
- The sping coils should be securely fixed with the coil spring compressor.
- Use high quality coil spring compressors.



Compress the spring by turning the lead screw of the coil spring compressor. Use a ratchet wrench.





AUTODOC recommends:

- Compress the coil spring compressor until there is enough room to remove the spring. Do not compress the tool to the full: the spring coils must not touch each other.
- Be careful. The compressed spring is powerful and in case of disrupting ties, straightening, it can cause injury.



Take out the stabiliser link fastener.



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Pull down the suspension control arm. Use a crowbar.





Remove the coil spring together with the coil spring compressor.







Replacement: coil springs – Nissan Qashqai J10. Tip from AUTODOC experts:

• While the spring is compressed, do not do any operations on it.



Secure the coil spring compressor on a work bench.





Decompress the spring.



19 Take out the spring.



Clean the coil spring mounting seats.

Inspect the rubber mounts of the suspension spring. Replace if necessary.



Install a new coil spring on the coil spring compressor.







AUTODOC recommends:

• Use adapters and jaws of the appropriate size.

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Compress the spring.

Install the coil spring together with the rubber mounts into the mounting seats.

Support the arm. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.

Tighten the stabiliser link fastener. Use a combination spanner #18. Use a drive socket #18. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 90 Nm torque.







Release the coil spring by turning the lead screw of the coil spring compressor. Use a ratchet wrench.



Replacement: coil springs – Nissan Qashqai J10. Professionals recommend:

• Make sure that the coil spring is correctly positioned in its mounting seats.

Remove the coil spring compressor.

Tighten the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a combination spanner #18. Use a drive socket #18. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 110 Nm torque.

Remove the support from under the rear arm.







AUTODOC recommends:

- Lower the hydraulic transmission jack smoothly, without jerks, to avoid damaging assemblies and mechanisms.

Clean the wheel rim mounting seat. Use a wire brush. Treat the contacting surface. Use copper grease.





Install the wheel.



AUTODOC recommends:

• Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts on the car. Nissan Qashqai J10

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Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #21.







Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 112 Nm torque.

Remove the jacks and chocks.






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
