

# How to change pollen filter on **RENAULT Clio II Van** – replacement guide


This replacement procedure can be used for: RENAULT Clio II Van 1.9 D, RENAULT Clio II Van 1.1, RENAULT Clio II Van 1.5 dCi, RENAULT Clio II Van 1.2

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: RENAULT Clio II Hatchback (BB, CB) 1.2














# **REPLACEMENT: POLLEN FILTER – RENAULT CLIO II VAN. USE THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE:**

Open the bonnet.

2

1

Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.

3

Remove the clips of the plastic cowl grille. Use a clip removal tool.



4

Remove the cowl grille seal.







5

Raise up and remove the cowl grille.



6

Clean the cabin filter housing and cover. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



7

Unscrew the fasteners of the cabin filter housing cover. Use a Phillips screwdriver.



8

Remove the cabin filter housing cover.



#### AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: pollen filter – RENAULT Clio II Van. To avoid damaging the part when removing it, do not use excessive force.





9

Remove the filter element from the filter housing.



### Replacement: pollen filter - RENAULT Clio II Van. Tip from AUTODOC:

• Do not attempt to clean and reuse the filter - it will affect the quality of air cleaning inside the car.

10

Insert a new filter element into the filter housing. Make sure that the filter edge fits tight to the housing.



#### AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: pollen filter RENAULT Clio II Van. Be sure to position the filtering element correctly. Avoid misalignment.
- Follow the air flow direction arrow on the filter.
- Take care to only use quality filters.

Reinstall the cabin filter housing cover.



12

Screw in the fasteners of the cabin filter housing cover. Use a Phillips screwdriver.



13

Install and secure the cowl grille.



14

Install the fasteners of the wiper plastic cowl grille.



15

Install the cowl grille seal.









Switch on the ignition.

Switch on the air conditioning system. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.

Switch off the ignition.

Remove the fender protection cover.

20 Close the hood.



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
