

How to change serpentine belt on **RENAULT Clio II Van** replacement guide


This replacement procedure can be used for: RENAULT Clio II Van 1.6

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: RENAULT Megane Scenic (JA) 1.6 16V











AUTODOC recommends:

 Please note: all work on the car – RENAULT Clio II Van – should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:



3

Secure the wheels with chocks. Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19.

Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.



4

Raise the car.

Open the bonnet.

Replacement: serpentine belt – RENAULT Clio II Van. Tip from AUTODOC:

- If you are using a jack, make sure it rests on a flat surface without any unevenness.
- Be sure to additionally secure the car with jack stands.





Unscrew the wheel bolts.



AUTODOC recommends:

• Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts. RENAULT Clio II Van

Remove the wheel.

Unscrew and remove the wheel arch cover fasteners. Use a Phillips screwdriver.

Remove the wheel arch cover.







Pull aside the V-ribbed belt tensioner pulley. Use a combination spanner #13.



10

Remove the V-ribbed belt.



Replacement: serpentine belt – RENAULT Clio II Van. Professionals recommend:

 Check the condition of the tensioner pulley and idler pulley. Replace them if necessary.



Install the V-ribbed belt.



AUTODOC recommends:

• Make sure that the V-ribbed belt fits all pulleys snugly.





Pull aside the V-ribbed belt tensioner pulley. Use a combination spanner #13.

Place the V-ribbed belt on the tensioner pulley. Return the tensioner pulley to its initial position.

Rotate the crankshaft several times to check whether the new V-ribbed belt is working correctly. Use a drive socket #18. Use a ratchet wrench.

Install the wheel arch cover to its mounting seat.







Install and tighten the wheel arch cover fasteners. Use a combination spanner #13.

Install the wheel.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Important! Hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts. RENAULT Clio II Van



Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19.








Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 90 Nm torque.






Remove the jacks and chocks.










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
