

This replacement procedure can be used for: RENAULT GRAND SCÉNIC III (JZ0/1_) 2.0 dCi

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

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Replacement: air filter – RENAULT GRAND SCÉNIC III (JZ0/1_). AUTODOC recommends:

- Follow the terms, recommendations and requirements of the part operation provided by the manufacturer.
- Please note: all work on the car RENAULT GRAND SCÉNIC III (JZ0/1_) should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.

Unscrew the fastener of the wiper cowl grille located on the left side. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.





Remove the rubber strip.

Open the bonnet.

Remove the wiper cowl grille located on the left side.



6

Unscrew fixing bolts of the protective cover. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.



7

Remove the protective cover.



8

Unscrew the filter housing fastening bolts. Use a Phillips screwdriver.


Raise a little the top protective cover. Remove the air filter housing.





10

Remove the filter element from the filter housing.



11

Clean the air filter cover and housing.



Replacement: air filter – RENAULT GRAND SCÉNIC III (JZ0/1_). Tip:

• Before cleaning the air filter cover and housing, cover the air duct parts, mass airflow sensor (if available), throttle valve with a clean cloth.




Insert a new filter element into the filter housing. Make sure that the filter edge fits tight to the housing.

Reinstall the air filter housing.



15

Screw the filter housing fastening bolts. Use a Phillips screwdriver.





16

Install the protective cover.



17

Tighten fixing bolts of the protective cover. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.



18

Install the wiper cowl grille on the left side.



19

Screw in the fastener of the wiper cowl grille located on the left side. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.



20

Install the rubber strip.







Remove the fender protection cover.

Close the hood.



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
