
This video shows the replacement procedure of a similar car part on another vehicle

(i) Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for: RENAULT LAGUNA I (B56_, 556_) 1.8, RENAULT LAGUNA I (B56_, 556_) 3.0, RENAULT LAGUNA I (B56_, 556_) 2.0, RENAULT LAGUNA I (B56_, 556_) 2.0 16V, RENAULT LAGUNA I (B56_, 556_) 3.0 24V, RENAULT LAGUNA I (B56_, 556_) 1.8 16V, RENAULT LAGUNA I (B56_, 556_) 1.6 16V, RENAULT LAGUNA I (B56_, 556_) 1.8 (F3P 676)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: RENAULT MEGANE II Saloon (LM0/1_) 1.4




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• Ensure adequate ventilation of the workplace. Fuel vapors are poisonous.

 Please note: all work on the car – RENAULT LAGUNA I (B56_, 556_) – should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:



Open the fuel door. Unscrew the fuel filler cap.

Lift the car and set it on jack stands.



Prepare a container for fluids.

Squeeze the clips and detach the fuel supply lines from the fuel filter housing. Use fuel line pliers.





Replacement: fuel filter – RENAULT LAGUNA I (B56_, 556_). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

• Be careful! Fuel may leak from the filter housing and hoses.

Remove the fuel filter. Use a crowbar. Put the old filter cartridge in the container.





Install a new fuel filter.



Replacement: fuel filter – RENAULT LAGUNA I (B56_, 556_). Professionals recommend:

- Remember, it is important not to mix up the input and output of the filter. Arrows on the filter indicate the direction of fuel flow.
- During installation, take care to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the fuel filter housing.
- Attention! Use quality filters RENAULT LAGUNA I (B56_, 556_).

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Connect the fuel lines to the fuel filter and lock the fastening clips.



Lower the car.

Tighten the fuel filler cap. Close the fuel door.



Replacement: fuel filter – RENAULT LAGUNA I (B56_, 556_). AUTODOC experts recommend:

• Before starting off, switch the ignition on and off several times. This should be done to activate the fuel pump to make it pump fuel through the fuel system.

Run the engine for a few minutes. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.

Shut off the engine.

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Replacement: fuel filter - RENAULT LAGUNA I (B56_, 556_). Tip:

• To protect the environment from pollution, be sure to dispose of the used filters at special collection points.



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
