### i Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for:

RENAULT LAGUNA III (BT0/1) 3.5 V6, RENAULT LAGUNA III (BT0/1) 2.0 16V, RENAULT LAGUNA III (BT0/1) 2.0 16V Turbo, RENAULT LAGUNA III (BT0/1) 2.0 GT, RENAULT LAGUNA III (BT0/1) 1.6 16V, RENAULT LAGUNA III (BT0/1) 2.0 16V Hi-Flex

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

## REPLACEMENT: FUEL FILTER – RENAULT LAGUNA III (BT0/1). LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Fuel line pliers
- Fluid container

## Replacement: fuel filter – RENAULT LAGUNA III (BT0/1). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Ensure adequate ventilation of the workplace. Fuel vapors are poisonous.
- Please note: all work on the car RENAULT LAGUNA III (BT0/1) should be done with the engine switched off.

#### CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

1

Open the fuel door. Unscrew the fuel filler cap.



- Lift the car and set it on jack stands.
- 3 Prepare a container for fluids.



Squeeze the clips and detach the fuel supply lines from the fuel filter housing. Use fuel line pliers.

## Replacement: fuel filter – RENAULT LAGUNA III (BT0/1). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

• Be careful! Fuel may leak from the filter housing and hoses.

Remove the fuel filter. Use a crowbar. Put the old filter cartridge in the container.

Install a new fuel filter.



### Replacement: fuel filter – RENAULT LAGUNA III (BT0/1). Professionals recommend:

- Remember, it is important not to mix up the input and output of the filter. Arrows
  on the filter indicate the direction of fuel flow.
- During installation, take care to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the fuel filter housing.
- Attention! Use quality filters RENAULT LAGUNA III (BT0/1).

Connect the fuel lines to the fuel filter and lock the fastening clips.



- Lower the car.
- Tighten the fuel filler cap. Close the fuel door.



### Replacement: fuel filter – RENAULT LAGUNA III (BT0/1). AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Before starting off, switch the ignition on and off several times. This should be done to activate the fuel pump to make it pump fuel through the fuel system.
- Run the engine for a few minutes. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.
- Shut off the engine.
