
This replacement procedure can be used for: RENAULT Megane I Convertible (EA) 1.6 e, RENAULT Megane I Convertible (EA) 2.0 16V, RENAULT Megane I Convertible (EA) 2.0, RENAULT Megane I Convertible (EA) 1.6 16V, RENAULT Megane I Convertible (EA) 2.0 i, RENAULT Megane I Convertible (EA) 1.4 16V, RENAULT Megane I Convertible (EA) 2.0 16V IDE

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: RENAULT Kangoo I (KC) 1.2 16V







Buy tools





AUTODOC recommends:

• Replace the stabiliser links on RENAULT Megane I Convertible (EA) in pairs.

- The replacement procedure is identical for both stabiliser links on the same axle.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: ANTI ROLL BAR LINKS – RENAULT MEGANE I CONVERTIBLE (EA). USE THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE:



Secure the wheels with chocks.





Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19.

Raise the front of the car and secure on supports.





Unscrew the wheel bolts.



Replacement: anti roll bar links – RENAULT Megane I Convertible (EA). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

• To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when unscrewing the bolts.

Remove the wheel.

Clean the stabiliser link fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.







Unscrew the stabilizer rod fasteners. Use a drive socket #13. Use a ratchet wrench.

Remove the stabilizer rod.



Replacement: anti roll bar links – RENAULT Megane I Convertible (EA). Tip from AUTODOC:

• Examine stabiliser bushes. Replace them if needed.

Clean all joints of the stabiliser link. Use a wire brush. Treat all joints of the stabiliser link. Use WD-40 spray.







Install a new rod, tighten the fasteners.

Support the stabilizer bar. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.

Tighten the stabiliser link fastener. Use Torx T45. Use a drive socket #13. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 35 Nm torque.

Remove the transmission jack from under the stabilizer bar.



Replacement: anti roll bar links - RENAULT Megane I Convertible (EA). Tip:

• Clean the wheel rim mounting seat.





Install the wheel.



AUTODOC recommends:

• Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts on the car. RENAULT Megane I Convertible (EA)

Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19.

Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 110 Nm torque.









Remove the jacks and chocks.
