This replacement procedure can be used for: RENAULT MEGANE II Box Body / Estate (KM_) 1.9 dCi (KM14)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: RENAULT SCÉNIC II (JM0/1_) 1.9 dCi



REPLACEMENT: SERPENTINE BELT – RENAULT MEGANE II BOX BODY / ESTATE (KM_). TOOLS YOU NEED:



- Wire brush
- Copper grease
- Drive socket # 13
- Drive socket # 16
- Torx bit T25
- Wheel impact socket #19

- Ratchet wrench
- Tap wrench
- Ear clamp pliers
- Fender cover
- Wheel chock

Replacement: serpentine belt – RENAULT MEGANE II Box Body / Estate (KM_).

AUTODOC recommends:

• All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: SERPENTINE BELT – RENAULT MEGANE II BOX BODY / ESTATE (KM_). TAKE THE FOLLOWING STEPS:

- Open the bonnet.
- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Secure the wheels with chocks.



Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19.



Lift the car using a jack or place it over an inspection pit.

6 Unscrew the wheel bolts.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Important! Hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts. RENAULT MEGANE II Box Body / Estate (KM_)
- Remove the wheel.

Unscrew and remove the wheel arch cover fasteners. Use ear clamp pliers. Use Torx T25. Use a ratchet wrench.



Remove the wheel arch cover.

Unscrew the fasteners connecting the bumper reinforcement bar to the subframe. Use a drive socket #13.



Pull aside the V-ribbed belt tensioner pulley. Use a drive socket #16. Use a tap wrench.



Remove the V-ribbed belt.

Return the tensioner pulley to its initial position.

Replacement: serpentine belt – RENAULT MEGANE II Box Body / Estate (KM_).

AUTODOC experts recommend:

 Check the condition of the tensioner pulley and idler pulley. Replace them if necessary.

14 Install the V-ribbed belt.



Replacement: serpentine belt – RENAULT MEGANE II Box Body / Estate (KM_).

Tip from AUTODOC:

- Make sure that the V-ribbed belt fits all pulleys snugly.
- Pull aside the V-ribbed belt tensioner pulley. Use a drive socket #16. Use a tap wrench.



- Place the V-ribbed belt on the tensioner pulley.
- Return the tensioner pulley to its initial position.

Screw in the fastener connecting the bumper reinforcement bar to the subframe. Use a drive socket #13.



Install the wheel arch cover to its mounting seat.



Install and tighten the wheel arch cover fasteners. Use Torx T25. Use a ratchet wrench.



Clean the wheel rim mounting seat. Use a wire brush. Treat the contacting surface. Use copper grease.

22 Install the wheel.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts on the car. RENAULT MEGANE II Box Body / Estate (KM_)
- Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19.



Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 110 nm torque.



- Remove the fender protection cover.
- Close the hood.
