RENAULT TRAFIC II Platform/Chassis (EL) 2.0, RENAULT TRAFIC II Platform/Chassis (EL) 1.9 dCi 80, RENAULT TRAFIC II Platform/Chassis (EL) 1.9 dCi 100, RENAULT TRAFIC II Platform/Chassis (EL) 2.5 dCi 135, RENAULT TRAFIC II Platform/Chassis (EL) 2.0 dCi 90, RENAULT TRAFIC II Platform/Chassis (EL) 2.0 dCi 115, RENAULT TRAFIC II Platform/Chassis (EL) 2.5 dCi 145 (EL0J)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.



REPLACEMENT: AUXILIARY INDICATOR - RENAULT TRAFIC II PLATFORM/CHASSIS (EL). TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



• Plastic trim removal tool

Replacement: auxiliary indicator – RENAULT Trafic II Platform/Chassis (EL). AUTODOC recommends:

- The procedure for replacing the right and left side indicators is identical.
- All the work should be carried out with the ignition switched off.

REPLACEMENT: AUXILIARY INDICATOR – RENAULT TRAFIC II PLATFORM/CHASSIS (EL). RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:

Remove the side indicator light. Use a plastic trim removal tool.



Detach the bulb holder from the side indicator light.



Attach the bulb holder to a new side indicator light.
