REPLACEMENT: TAILGATE STRUTS - RENAULT TWINGO I BOX (S06_). TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



• Flat Screwdriver

• Hydraulic transmission jack

Replacement: tailgate struts – RENAULT TWINGO I Box (S06_). Tip from AUTODOC:

- Right and left gas struts of the boot lid should be replaced simultaneously.
- The replacement procedure is identical for the right and left gas struts of the boot lid.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: TAILGATE STRUTS – RENAULT TWINGO I BOX (S06_). TAKE THE FOLLOWING STEPS:

Open the boot lid.

Support the boot lid. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



Release the circlip connecting the gas strut to the boot lid. Use a flat screwdriver.

Release the circlip connecting the gas strut to the car body. Use a flat screwdriver.



Replacement: tailgate struts - RENAULT TWINGO I Box (S06_). Tip:

- To avoid any injuries, be sure to hold the boot lid while demounting the gas struts.
- 5 Remove the boot lid gas strut.



Install the new boot lid gas strut.

7 Snap on the circlip connecting the gas strut to the car body.



Snap on the circlip connecting the gas strut to the boot lid.



Remove the hydraulic transmission jack.



Replacement: tailgate struts – RENAULT TWINGO I Box (S06_). AUTODOC recommends:

- Lower the hydraulic transmission jack smoothly, without jerks, to avoid damaging assemblies and mechanisms.
- Check the working condition of the boot lid gas springs after they are installed.
