This replacement procedure can be used for: SEAT Alhambra (7V8, 7V9) 1.9 TDI, SEAT Alhambra (7V8, 7V9) 1.9 TDI 4motion, SEAT Alhambra (7V8, 7V9) 2.0 TDI

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: VW SHARAN (7M8, 7M9, 7M6) 1.9 TDI



REPLACEMENT: FUEL FILTER – SEAT ALHAMBRA (7V8, 7V9). LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- All-purpose cleaning spray
- Drive socket # 8
- Ratchet wrench

- Clic-R collar pliers
- Hand-operated fluid syringe
- Fender cover

Replacement: fuel filter – SEAT Alhambra (7V8, 7V9). AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Ensure adequate ventilation of the workplace. Fuel vapors are poisonous.
- Please note: all work on the car SEAT Alhambra (7V8, 7V9) should be done
 with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

- Open the hood.
- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Clean the fuel filter. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



Loosen the fastening clamps of the fuel filter pipes. Use clic-R collar pliers.

5 Detach the tubes from the fuel filter.



Replacement: fuel filter – SEAT Alhambra (7V8, 7V9). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Be careful! Fuel may leak from the filter housing and hoses.
- Detach the filter from its fasteners.
- Remove the retaining clip that secures the fuel filter pipe.



Disconnect the pipe from the fuel filter.

9 Remove the fuel filter.



Put the old filter cartridge in the container.



Unscrew the bracket fastener. Use a drive socket #8. Use a ratchet wrench.



Remove the bracket.



13 Install the bracket onto the new filter.

Screw in the bracket fastener. Use a drive socket #8. Use a ratchet wrench.



Clean the fuel filter pipe. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



16 Install a new fuel filter.



Replacement: fuel filter – SEAT Alhambra (7V8, 7V9). Professionals recommend:

- During installation, take care to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the fuel filter housing.
- Attention! Use quality filters SEAT Alhambra (7V8, 7V9).

Connect the pipe to the fuel filter.



Secure the fuel filter pipe with the retaining clip.



Secure the filter on its mounting seat.



- Connect the pipe to the fuel filter.
- Attach the fuel pipe clamp. Use clic-R collar pliers.

Pump the fuel out of the fuel filter housing. Use a hand-operated fluid syringe.



Connect the pipe to the fuel filter.



Attach the fuel pipe clamp. Use clic-R collar pliers.



Clean the fuel filter. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



- Run the engine for a few minutes. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.
- Shut off the engine.
- Remove the fender protection cover.
- Close the hood.
