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
How to change front strut mount on **SEAT Mii** (**KF1_**) – replacement guide

This video shows the replacement procedure of a similar car part on another vehicle

(i) Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for: SEAT Mii (KF1_) 1.0, SEAT Mii (KF1_) 1.0 EcoFuel, SEAT Mii (KF1_) electric

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 1.4 16V

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REPLACEMENT: STRUT MOUNT – SEAT MII (KF1_). TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Brake cleaner
- Copper grease
- Combination spanner #18
- Drive socket # 16
- Drive socket # 18
- Drive socket # 20
- Drive socket # 21

- Wheel impact socket #17
- Ratchet wrench
- Torque wrench
- Hammer
- Hydraulic strut spring compressor
- Hydraulic transmission jack
- Fender cover
- Wheel chock

Buy tools

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Replacement: strut mount – SEAT Mii (KF1_). Tip from AUTODOC:

- The replacement procedure is identical for the mounts of the left and right shock struts of the front suspension.
- All mounts of the front shock struts should be replaced simultaneously.
- Be sure to replace all self-locking nuts and bolts during installation.
- Please note: all work on the car SEAT Mii (KF1_) should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

1

Secure the wheels with chocks.



- Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.
- Raise the front of the car and secure on supports.

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4 Unscrew the wheel bolts.



Replacement: strut mount – SEAT Mii (KF1_). AUTODOC experts recommend:

- To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when unscrewing the bolts.
- Remove the wheel.



- 6 Clean the stabiliser link fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.
- Unscrew the fastener connecting the stabilizer bar with the control arm. Use a drive socket #16. Use a ratchet wrench.



Remove the fastening bolt.

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Disconnect the wiring from the bracket on the shock strut.



- Clean the fasteners connecting the shock strut to the steering knuckle. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.
- Unscrew the lower fastener connecting the shock strut to the steering knuckle. Use a combination spanner #18. Use a drive socket #18. Use a ratchet wrench.



- Remove the fastening bolt.
- Disconnect the steering knuckle from the shock absorber strut. Use a hammer.



- Lower the car.
- 15 Open the hood.
- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Clean the fasteners of the shock strut upper mount. Use WD-40 spray.

Unscrew the top fastening of the shock strut mount. Use a drive socket #21. Use a ratchet wrench.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Important! Hold the suspension strut while unscrewing the fastening bolts. SEAT Mii (KF1_)
- 19 Remove the suspension strut.



20 Set the shock absorber strut on the spring compressor tool.



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Replacement: strut mount – SEAT Mii (KF1_). Tip:

- Note that when using a spring compressor, spring coils need to be securely gripped, compressing the spring on the opposite sides.
- Ensure the correct position of the spring in the retainer.
- Make sure that the spring coils tightly entered the lock handles.
- Compress the spring.



- Treat the shock strut rod. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.
- Remove the strut piston rod nut. Use a drive socket #20. Use a ratchet wrench.



Remove the top strut mount.



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Replacement: strut mount – SEAT Mii (KF1_). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Examine the shock absorber dust cap and the bump stop. Replace them if necessary.
- Clean the mounting seat of the shock strut mount. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.
- 26 Install a new strut mount.



Tighten the shock strut piston rod nut. Use a drive socket #20. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 60 Nm torque.



Replacement: strut mount – SEAT Mii (KF1_). Professionals recommend:

• Check to make sure the spring is positioned correctly. Avoid its misalignment.

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Decompress the spring.



- Remove the assembled shock strut.
- Install the shock strut into the wheel arch.



Screw the top fastening of the shock strut mount. Use a drive socket #21. Do not tighten it.

AUTODOC recommends:

- SEAT Mii (KF1_) To avoid injury, hold the suspension strut while screwing in the fastening bolts.
- Tighten the upper fastener of the shock absorber strut mount. Use a drive socket #21. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 60 nm torque.



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- Remove the fender protection cover.
- Close the hood.
- Raise the front of the car and secure on supports.
- Prop up the steering knuckle. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



- Fix the shock absorber strut on the steering knuckle. Use a hammer.
- 38 Install the fastening bolt.
- Tighten the lower fasteners connecting the shock strut to the steering knuckle. Use a combination spanner #18. Use a drive socket #18. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 60 Nm torque.+90°



AUTODOC recommends:

Important! Be sure to use new fasteners.

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Connect the wiring to the bracket on the shock strut.



Remove the support from under the steering knuckle.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: strut mount SEAT Mii (KF1_). Lower the transmission jack smoothly, without jerks, to avoid damaging components and mechanisms.
- Install the fastening bolt.
- Tighten the fastener connecting the stabilizer bar with the control arm. Use a drive socket #16. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 15 Nm torque.+90°



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AUTODOC recommends:

- Important! Be sure to use new fasteners.
- Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use copper grease.
- Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.



Replacement: strut mount – SEAT Mii (KF1_). AUTODOC recommends:

- After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.
- 46 Install the wheel.



AUTODOC recommends:

• Important! Hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts. SEAT Mii (KF1_)

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Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



- Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 120 Nm torque.
- Remove the jacks and chocks.





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
