

How to change engine oil and filter on **SEAT TOLEDO I (1L)** – replacement guide

This video shows the replacement procedure of a similar car part on another vehicle

i Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for: SEAT TOLEDO I (1L) 1.6 i, SEAT TOLEDO I (1L) 1.8 16V, SEAT TOLEDO I (1L) 1.8 i, SEAT TOLEDO I (1L) 2.0 i, SEAT TOLEDO I (1L) 2.0 i 16V

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: SEAT Leon Hatchback (1M1) 1.8 20V

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REPLACEMENT: ENGINE OIL AND FILTER – SEAT TOLEDO I (1L). TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Wire brush
- All-purpose cleaning spray
- Torque wrench
- Drive socket #19
- Oil filter cup socket 76-14F

- Ratchet wrench
- Funnel
- Oil drain pan
- Fender cover

Buy tools

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Replacement: engine oil and filter – SEAT TOLEDO I (1L). AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Replace the oil filter every time when changing motor oil.
- · Wear gloves to prevent contact with hot liquid.
- Please note: all work on the car SEAT TOLEDO I (1L) should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

- Open the bonnet.
- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Pull up the oil dipstick.



4 Unscrew the oil filler plug.



Lift the car using a jack or place it over an inspection pit.


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Replacement: engine oil and filter – SEAT TOLEDO I (1L). Tip:

• The vehicle must be on a level surface, but if it is at an angle, the drain plug must be at the lowest point.





Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use a wire brush. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.

Unscrew the drain plug. Use a drive socket #19. Use a ratchet wrench.



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9 Drain the used oil.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Caution! The oil may be hot.
- Wait until the oil has completely drained from the drainage hole.
- Clean the oil filter. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



Unscrew the oil filter. Use the 76-14F socket. Use a ratchet wrench.



Remove the oil filter.



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- Clean the oil filter seat. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.
- Lubricate the rubber seal of the new filter with a little amount of fresh oil.



15 Install a new oil filter.

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Tighten the oil filter. Remember to observe the recommended tightening torque. Use the 76-14F socket. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 24 Nm torque.



Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



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Screw in the new drainage plug and tighten it. Use a drive socket #19. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 30 Nm torque.



Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



- Lower the car.
- Remove the oil filler cap.



22 Insert the funnel.



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Pour new oil into the engine in the amount recommended by the car manufacturer.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – SEAT TOLEDO I (1L). AUTODOC experts recommend:

• Use the oil recommended by the manufacturer.

Check the oil level using the dipstick.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Top up oil if necessary.
- The oil level should be between the Min and Max marks.

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Tighten the oil filler cap.



- Run the engine for a few minutes.
- After the oil pressure warning light goes out, stop the engine.

Replacement: engine oil and filter – SEAT TOLEDO I (1L). Professionals recommend:

- Note that oil pressure warning light, which indicates insufficient pressure in the lubrication system, may be on for a longer time than usual. After a few seconds, the oil will fill all the channels, and the light will go out.
- Check the oil level with a dipstick 5 minutes after turning the engine off and add oil if necessary.



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Please note!

- The oil level should be between the Min and Max marks.
- Make sure that the oil filler cap is properly tightened.
- Check the threaded plug of the drainage hole and the oil filter seal for tightness.
 If necessary, carefully tighten them up.
- Remove the fender protection cover.
- Close the bonnet.

Replacement: engine oil and filter – SEAT TOLEDO I (1L). AUTODOC recommends:

• To protect the environment from pollution, be sure to dispose of the used filters at special collection points.



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
