This video shows the replacement procedure of a similar car part on another vehicle

i Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for:

SEAT Toledo II Saloon (1M2) 1.6, SEAT Toledo II Saloon (1M2) 1.8 20V, SEAT Toledo II Saloon (1M2) 2.3 V5, SEAT Toledo II Saloon (1M2) 1.9 TDI, SEAT Toledo II Saloon (1M2) 1.4 16V, SEAT Toledo II Saloon (1M2) 1.6 16V, SEAT Toledo II Saloon (1M2) 2.3 V5 20V, SEAT Toledo II Saloon (1M2) 1.8 20VT, SEAT Toledo II Saloon (1M2) 1.9 TDI 4Drive

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: VW Polo Saloon (602, 604, 612, 614) 1.6

REPLACEMENT: COIL SPRINGS – SEAT TOLEDO II SALOON (1M2). LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Copper grease
- Combination spanner #16
- Drive socket # 16
- Wheel impact socket #17
- Ratchet wrench
- Torque wrench
- Tap wrench
- Crow bar
- Hydraulic transmission jack
- Wheel chock

Buy tools

Replacement: coil springs – SEAT Toledo II Saloon (1M2). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Both coil springs of the rear suspension should be replaced simultaneously.
- The replacement procedure is identical for the left and right coil springs of the rear suspension.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: COIL SPRINGS – SEAT TOLEDO II SALOON (1M2). TAKE THE FOLLOWING STEPS:

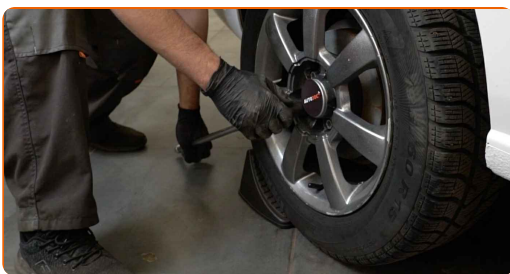

Secure the wheels with chocks.



2

Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



3

Raise the rear of the car and secure on supports.

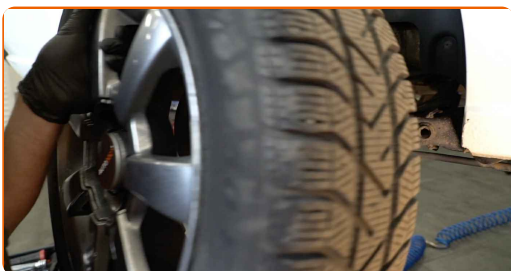
4 Unscrew the wheel bolts.



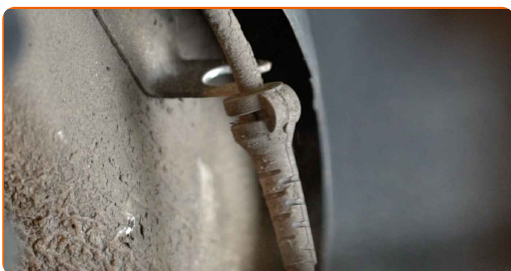
Replacement: coil springs – SEAT Toledo II Saloon (1M2). Tip:

- To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when unscrewing the bolts.

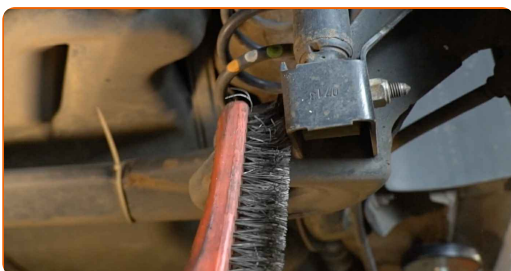
5 Remove the wheel.



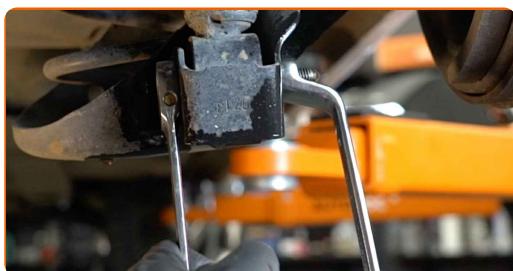
6 Disconnect the ABS sensor wiring. Use a crowbar.



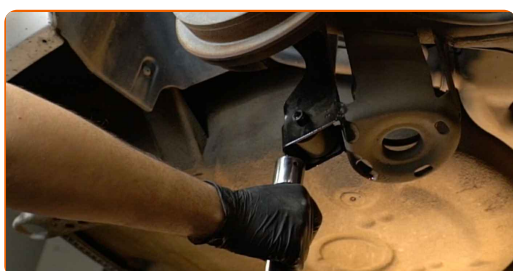
7 Clean the shock absorber fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



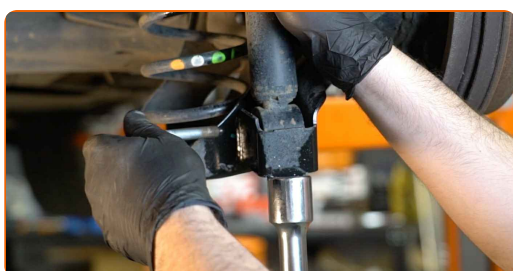
- 8 Unscrew the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a combination spanner #16. Use a drive socket #16. Use a tap wrench.



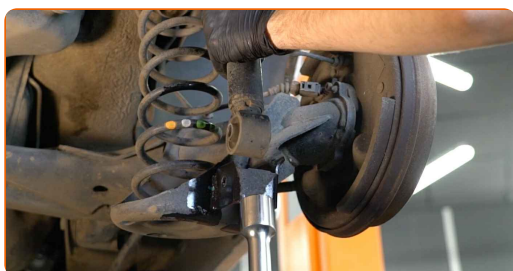
- 9 Support the rear suspension beam. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



- 10 Remove the fastening bolt. Use a combination spanner #16. Use a drive socket #16. Use a ratchet wrench.



- 11 Remove the mounting from under the rear axle beam.



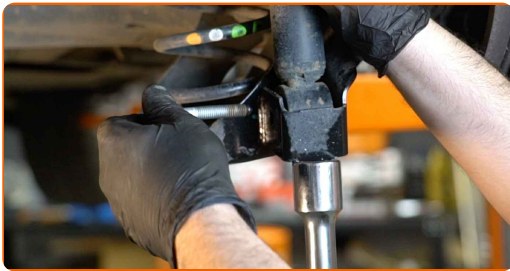
AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: coil springs – SEAT Toledo II Saloon (1M2). Lower the transmission jack smoothly, without jerks, to avoid damaging components and mechanisms.

12 Support the rear suspension beam. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.

13 Unscrew the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a combination spanner #16. Use a drive socket #16. Use a tap wrench.

14 Remove the fastening bolt. Use a combination spanner #16. Use a drive socket #16. Use a ratchet wrench.



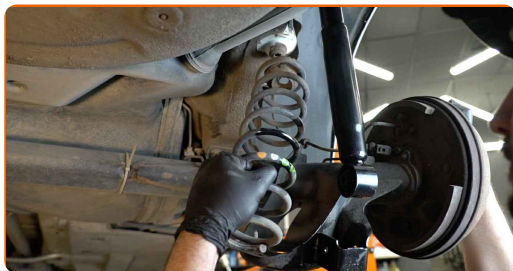
15 Remove the mounting from under the rear axle beam.



AUTODOC recommends:

- SEAT Toledo II Saloon (1M2) – Do not lower the transmission jack sharply to avoid damaging components and mechanisms of the car.

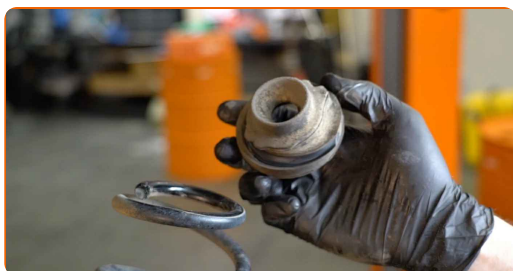
16 Take out the spring.



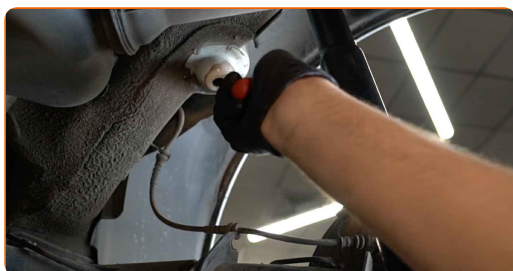
Replacement: coil springs – SEAT Toledo II Saloon (1M2). AUTODOC recommends:

- Inspect the rubber mounts of the suspension spring. Replace if necessary.

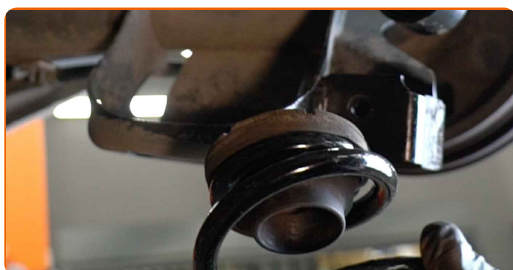
17 Remove the rubber spring spacer.



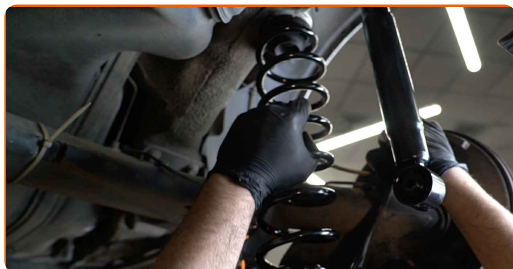
18 Clean the coil spring mounting seats. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



19 Install the rubber spacer on the new coil spring.

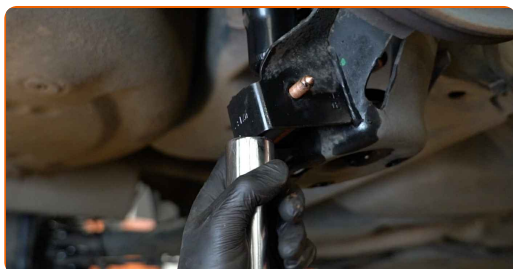


20 Install the coil spring together with the rubber mounts into the mounting seats.



21 Support the rear suspension beam. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.

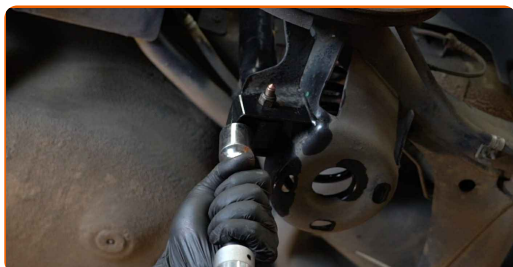
22 Install the fastening bolt.



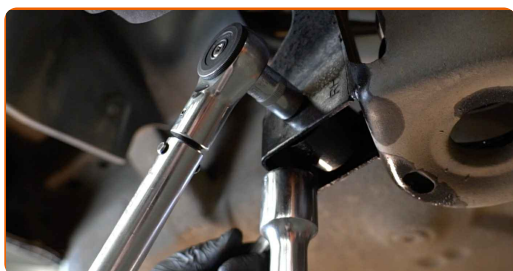
23 Screw in the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a combination spanner #16. Use a drive socket #16. Use a ratchet wrench.



24 Raise the hydraulic transmission jack by 10-15 cm.



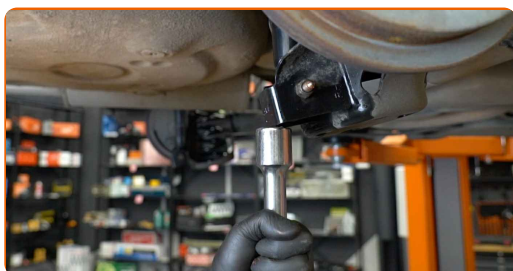
- 25** Tighten the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a combination spanner #16. Use a drive socket #16. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 40 Nm torque.+90°



AUTODOC recommends:

- Important! Be sure to use new fasteners.

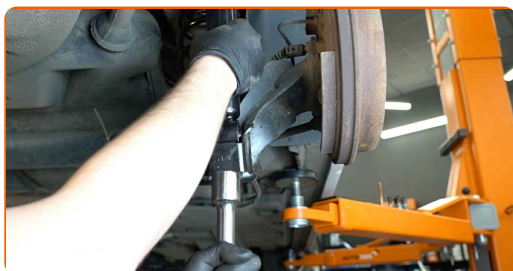
- 26** Remove the mounting from under the rear axle beam.



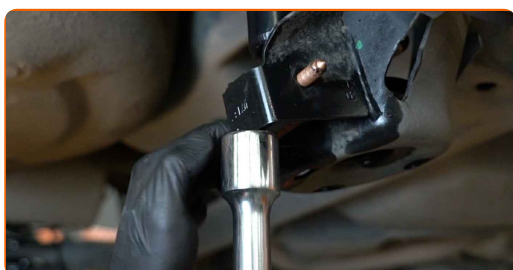
Replacement: coil springs – SEAT Toledo II Saloon (1M2). AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Lower the hydraulic transmission jack smoothly, without jerks, to avoid damaging assemblies and mechanisms.

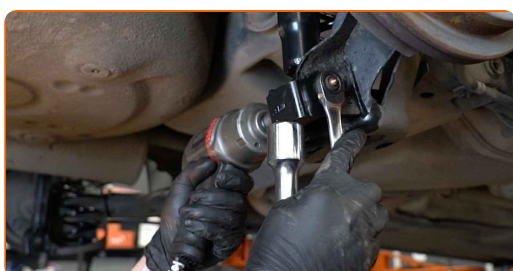
27 Support the rear suspension beam. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



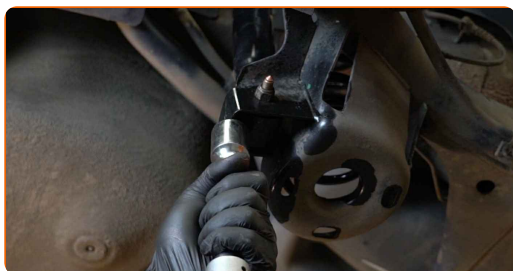
28 Install the fastening bolt.



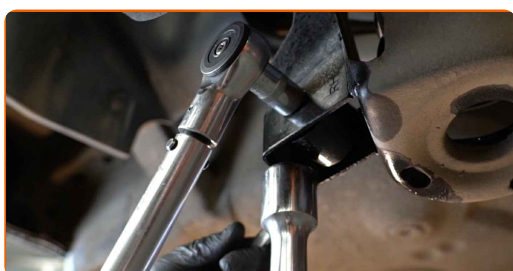
29 Screw in the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a combination spanner #16. Use a drive socket #16. Use a ratchet wrench.



30 Raise the hydraulic transmission jack by 10-15 cm.



31 Tighten the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a combination spanner #16. Use a drive socket #16. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 40 Nm torque. +90°



AUTODOC recommends:

- Important! Be sure to use new fasteners.

Remove the mounting from under the rear axle beam.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: coil springs – SEAT Toledo II Saloon (1M2). Lower the transmission jack smoothly, without jerks, to avoid damaging components and mechanisms.

Connect the ABS sensor wiring.

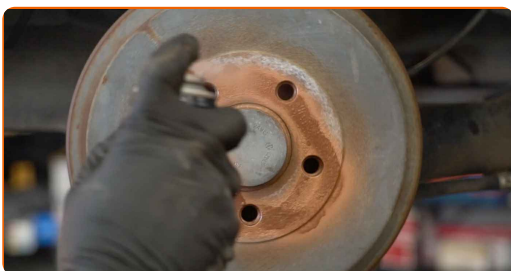
Treat the shock absorber fasteners. Use copper grease.



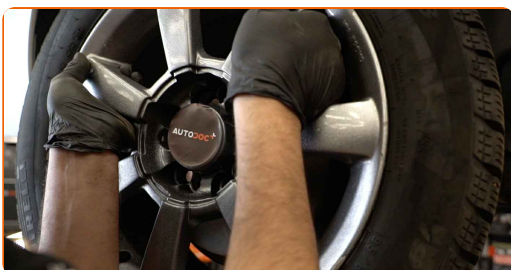
35 Clean the wheel rim mounting seat. Use a wire brush.



36 Treat the surface where the wheel rim contacts the brake drum. Use copper grease.



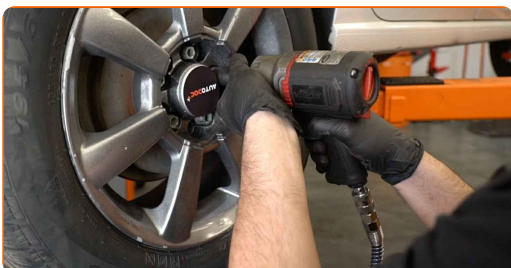
37 Install the wheel.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts on the car. SEAT Toledo II Saloon (1M2)

38 Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



- 39** Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 120 Nm torque.



- 40** Remove the jacks and chocks.
