The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.



### REPLACEMENT: TAILGATE STRUTS – VW SHARAN 1. LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- WD-40 spray
- Flat screwdriver

• Hydraulic transmission jack

#### Replacement: tailgate struts – VW Sharan 1. Tip from AUTODOC:

- Right and left gas struts of the boot lid should be replaced simultaneously.
- The replacement procedure is identical for the right and left gas struts of the boot lid.
- Please note: all work on the car VW Sharan 1 should be done with the engine switched off.

#### CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

Open the boot lid.



2

Support the boot lid. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.




