This replacement procedure can be used for: SKODA 130 Saloon 1.3 G,GL

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: VW Lupo (6X1, 6E1) 1.0

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REPLACEMENT: AIR FILTER – SKODA 130 SALOON. TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Torque wrench
- HEX bit no.H5.
- Ratchet wrench

- Phillips Screwdriver
- Microfibre towel
- Fender cover

Buy tools

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Replacement: air filter – SKODA 130 Saloon. Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Follow the terms, recommendations and requirements of the part operation provided by the manufacturer.
- Please note: all work on the car SKODA 130 Saloon should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

- Open the bonnet.
- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Undo the fastening screws of the air filter cover. Use a Phillips screwdriver. Use HEX No.H5. Use a ratchet wrench.



Remove the fastening bolts.



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Take off the filter lid.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: air filter SKODA 130 Saloon. Do not use excessive force when removing the part as this may damage it.
- Remove the filter element from the filter housing.



Cover the air intake hose with a microfibre towel to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the system.



Clean the air filter cover and housing.



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- 9 Remove the microfibre towel from the air intake hose.
- Insert a new filter element into the filter housing. Make sure that the filter edge fits tight to the housing.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Check out the correct location of the filter element. Do not skew.
- Attention! Use quality filters SKODA 130 Saloon.
- During installation, make sure to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the air filter housing.
- Reinstall the air filter cover. Fasten it.



12 Install the fastening bolts.



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Screw in the fastening screws of the air filter cover. Use a Phillips screwdriver. Use HEX No.H5. Use a ratchet wrench.



Tighten the fastening screws of the air filter cover. Use HEX No.H5. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 8 Nm torque.



- Remove the fender protection cover.
- Close the hood.



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
