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How to change spark plugs on **SKODA FELICIA II (6U1)** – replacement guide

This replacement procedure can be used for: SKODA FELICIA II (6U1) 1.3

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: SEAT Leon Hatchback (1M1) 1.8 20V

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REPLACEMENT: SPARK PLUGS – SKODA FELICIA II (6U1). TOOLS YOU NEED:



- High-temperature anti-seize lubricant
- Torque wrench
- Spark plug socket # 16

- Ratchet wrench
- Fender cover

Buy tools

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AUTODOC recommends:

- The replacement procedure is the same for all spark plugs.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: SPARK PLUGS – SKODA FELICIA II (6U1). USE THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE:

- 1 Open the bonnet.
- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Disconnect the spark plug wires from the spark plugs.



AUTODOC recommends:

- · Be careful to avoid damaging spark plug wires.
- Remember the position of the spark plug wires.

Clean dirt, dust and debris from inside the spark plug wells.



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Unscrew the spark plugs. Use the spark plug socket #16. Use a ratchet wrench.



Take out the spark plugs.

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Apply a thin layer of a special high temperature anti-seize lubricant to the threads of the new spark plugs.



Install the new spark plugs into their mounting seats.



Replacement: spark plugs – SKODA FELICIA II (6U1). AUTODOC experts recommend:

• Lower the spark plugs into the wells carefully, making sure not to damage the electrode gap.

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Screw new spark plugs and tighten them. Use the spark plug socket #16. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 26 nm torque.



Replacement: spark plugs – SKODA FELICIA II (6U1). Tip:

- Don't tighten the plugs with excessive force. Exceeding tightening torque can damage the thread connection.
- Be careful when working with a spark plug wrench. Its skewing can cause damage to the threaded connection.

Connect the spark plug wires to the spark plugs.

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AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: spark plugs – SKODA FELICIA II (6U1). Follow the installation steps.

Run the engine for a few minutes. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.

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Shut off the engine.

Remove the fender protection cover.

Close the bonnet.




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
