SKODA Octavia III Combi (5E5) 1.2 TSI, SKODA Octavia III Combi (5E5) 1.4 TSI, SKODA Octavia III Combi (5E5) 1.8 TSI, SKODA Octavia III Combi (5E5) 1.6 TDI, SKODA Octavia III Combi (5E5) 2.0 TDI, SKODA Octavia III Combi (5E5) 1.6 TDI 4x4, SKODA Octavia III Combi (5E5) 1.8 TSI 4x4, SKODA Octavia III Combi (5E5) 2.0 TDI 4x4, SKODA Octavia III Combi (5E5) 2.0 TDI RS, SKODA Octavia III Combi (5E5) 2.0 TSI RS, SKODA Octavia III Combi (5E5) 1.4 TSI G-TEC, SKODA Octavia III Combi (5E5) 1.6, SKODA Octavia III Combi (5E5) 2.0 TDI / TDI RS 4x4, SKODA Octavia III Combi (5E5) 1.0 TSI, SKODA Octavia III Combi (5E5) 1.5 TSI, (+ 3)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: VW Golf VII Hatchback (5G1, BQ1, BE1, BE2) 1.8 TSI

Replacement: pollen filter – SKODA Octavia III Combi (5E5). List of the tools you'll need:

- Replace the cabin filter at least once every six months, in early spring and autumn seasons.
- Follow the terms, recommendations and requirements of the part operation provided by the manufacturer.
- If the air flow into the cabin has sharply reduced, replace the filter before a scheduled maintenance.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

**CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:**

**1** Open the glove box.



**2** Press down on the glove box retainers.



**3** Detach the stopper (strap) from the glove box lid.



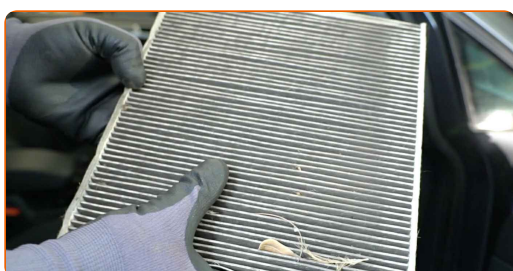
**4** Release the cabin filter cover clips.



**5** Remove the cabin filter housing cover.



**6** Remove the cabin filter.



Replacement: pollen filter – SKODA Octavia III Combi (5E5). Tip from AUTODOC:

- Do not attempt to clean and reuse the filter - it will affect the quality of air cleaning inside the car.

**7** Insert a new filter element into the filter housing.



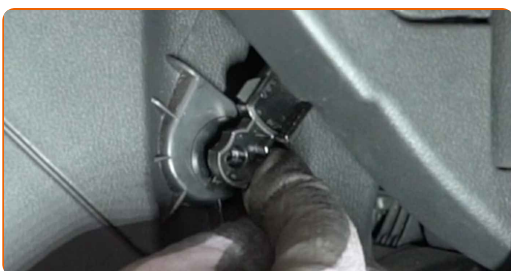
**AUTODOC recommends:**

- Replacement: pollen filter – SKODA Octavia III Combi (5E5). Be sure to position the filtering element correctly. Avoid misalignment.
- Follow the air flow direction arrow on the filter.

**8** Reinstall the cabin filter housing cover. Make sure you hear a click indicating that it is locked in place.



**9** Attach the stopper (strap) to the glove box lid.



**10**

Close the glove box.

**11**

Switch on the ignition.

**12**

Switch on the air conditioning system. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.

**13**

Switch off the ignition.
