This video shows the replacement procedure of a similar car part on another vehicle

#### **Important!**

This replacement procedure can be used for:

SUZUKI SWIFT IV (FZ, NZ) 1.2 (AZH 412), SUZUKI SWIFT IV (FZ, NZ) 1.2 4x4 (AZH 412), SUZUKI SWIFT IV (FZ, NZ) 1.4 (AZH 414), SUZUKI SWIFT IV (FZ, NZ) 1.2 (AZG 412), SUZUKI SWIFT IV (FZ, NZ) 1.2 4x4 (AZG 412), SUZUKI SWIFT IV (FZ, NZ) 1.6 (AZG 416, AZH 416, RS416), SUZUKI SWIFT IV (FZ, NZ) 1.2 (AZH 412, AZG 412), SUZUKI SWIFT IV (FZ, NZ) 1.2 4WD (AZH 412, AZG 412), SUZUKI SWIFT IV (FZ, NZ) 1.2, SUZUKI SWIFT IV (FZ, NZ) 1.2 VVT

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: SUZUKI SWIFT III (MZ, EZ) 1.5 (RS 415)

Replacement: pollen filter – SUZUKI SWIFT IV (FZ, NZ). AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Replace the cabin filter at least once every six months, in early spring and autumn seasons.
- Follow the terms, recommendations and requirements of the part operation provided by the manufacturer.
- If the air flow into the cabin has sharply reduced, replace the filter before a scheduled maintenance.
- Please note: all work on the car – SUZUKI SWIFT IV (FZ, NZ) – should be done with the engine switched off.

## CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

1

Open the glove box.



2

Detach the stopper (strap) from the glove box lid.



**3** Remove the cabin filter housing cover.



**4** Remove the cabin filter.



Replacement: pollen filter – SUZUKI SWIFT IV (FZ, NZ). Tip from AUTODOC:

- Do not attempt to clean and reuse the filter - it will affect the quality of air cleaning inside the car.

**5** Install the cabin filter to its mounting seat.



**AUTODOC recommends:**

- Replacement: pollen filter – SUZUKI SWIFT IV (FZ, NZ). Be sure to position the filtering element correctly. Avoid misalignment.
- Follow the air flow direction arrow on the filter.
- Attention! Use quality filters – SUZUKI SWIFT IV (FZ, NZ).

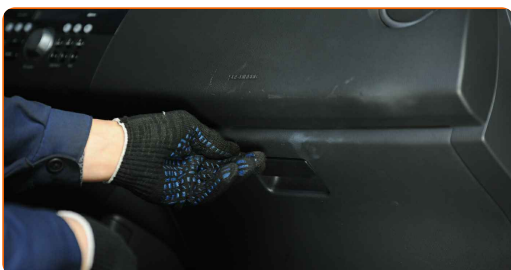
**6** Reinstall the cabin filter housing cover. Make sure you hear a click indicating that it is locked in place.



**7** Attach the stopper (strap) to the glove box lid.



**8** Close the glove box.



**9** Switch on the ignition.

**10** Switch on the air conditioning system. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.

**11** Switch off the ignition.
