This replacement procedure can be used for: TOYOTA COROLLA Estate (_E12J_, _E12T_) 1.8 (ZZE122), TOYOTA COROLLA Estate (_E12J_, _E12T_) 1.5 (NZE121_)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.



REPLACEMENT: BRAKE DRUM – TOYOTA COROLLA ESTATE (_E12J_, _E12T_). LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Copper grease

- Wheel impact socket #21
- Torque wrench
- Wheel chock

Replacement: brake drum – TOYOTA COROLLA Estate (_E12J_, _E12T_). Professionals recommend:

- Replace the brake drums on TOYOTA COROLLA Estate (_E12J_, _E12T_) in pair for the rear axle. Disregarding the parts state. It ensures even braking.
- The replacement procedure is identical for the right and left brake drums on the same axle.
- When replacing the brake drums, be sure to also change the brake shoes.
- Please note: all work on the car TOYOTA COROLLA Estate (_E12J_, _E12T_) should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

- Open the bonnet. Unscrew the brake fluid reservoir cap.
- Secure the wheels with chocks.
- Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #21.



Raise the rear of the car and secure on supports.

5 Unscrew the wheel bolts.



Replacement: brake drum – TOYOTA COROLLA Estate (_E12J_, _E12T_).

AUTODOC experts recommend:

- To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when unscrewing the bolts.
- Remove the wheel.



- 7 Fully lower the parking brake lever.
- Remove the brake drum.



Replacement: brake drum - TOYOTA COROLLA Estate (_E12J_, _E12T_). Tip:

• Examine the brake shoes. Replace them if needed.

Clean the hub. Use a wire brush. Treat the contacting surface. Use copper grease.



Move the parking brake shoes against the drum.



11 Install a brake drum.



Treat the surface where the wheel rim contacts the brake drum. Use copper grease.



13 Install the wheel.

Replacement: brake drum – TOYOTA COROLLA Estate (_E12J_, _E12T_). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

• To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when screwing in the fastening bolts.





Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #21. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 103 Nm torque.



16 Remove the jacks and chocks.

AUTODOC recommends:

- Important! Replacement: brake drum TOYOTA COROLLA Estate (_E12J_, _E12T_). Check the brake fluid level in the reservoir and top up if necessary.
- Tighten the brake fluid reservoir cap. Close the hood.
- Adjust the gap between the brake shoes and the drum on TOYOTA COROLLA Estate (_E12J_, _E12T_), pressing the brake pedal 10-15 times.
