How to change spark plugs on **TOYOTA Harrier II (XU30)** – replacement guide



This replacement procedure can be used for: TOYOTA Harrier II (XU30) 2.4 4WD (ACU35_)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: TOYOTA PRIUS Hatchback (NHW20_) 1.5 Hybrid (NHW2_)







Replacement: spark plugs – TOYOTA Harrier II (XU30). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

• The replacement procedure is the same for all spark plugs.

• All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: SPARK PLUGS – TOYOTA HARRIER II (XU30). TAKE THE FOLLOWING STEPS:

Unscrew the fasteners of the windscreen wiper arms. Use a drive socket #14. Use a ratchet wrench.

Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.

Remove the wiper arms.

Open the bonnet.

Remove the wiper arm covers. Use a clip removal tool.



6

Treat the fasteners of the windscreen wiper linkage. Use WD-40 spray.



7

Detach the windscreen wiper connector.



8

Unscrew the fasteners of the windscreen wiper linkage panel. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.





Unscrew the fasteners of the fuse box. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.



10

Remove the panel assembled with the windscreen wiper linkage.



11

Clean the ignition coils.



12

Unscrew the fasteners of the ignition coils. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.



13

Take out the ignition coils from the spark plug wells.

Replacement: spark plugs – TOYOTA Harrier II (XU30). AUTODOC recommends:

• Remember the sequence of steps for ignition coil demounting.

Clean dirt, dust and debris from inside the spark plug wells.



15

Unscrew the spark plugs. Use the spark plug socket #16. Use a ratchet wrench.



16

Take out the spark plugs.



17

Apply a thin layer of a special high temperature anti-seize lubricant to the threads of the new spark plugs.





Install the new spark plugs into their mounting seats. Use the spark plug socket #16.



19

Screw new spark plugs and tighten them. Use the spark plug socket #16. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 18 nm torque.



Replacement: spark plugs – TOYOTA Harrier II (XU30). Professionals recommend:

- Don't tighten the plugs with excessive force. Exceeding tightening torque can damage the thread connection.
- Be careful when working with a spark plug wrench. Its skewing can cause damage to the threaded connection.



Treat the ignition coil tips. Use high-temperature grease.





Install the ignition coils to the spark plug wells. Make sure you hear a click indicating that it is locked in place.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: spark plugs TOYOTA Harrier II (XU30). Follow the installation steps.
- Tighten the fasteners of the ignition coils. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.

Install the panel assembled with the windscreen wiper linkage.

Screw in the fasteners of the fuse box. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.

Install the wiper arm covers.




