This replacement procedure can be used for: TOYOTA Vios / Yaris II Saloon (XP9) 1.0 (KSP90_)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: TOYOTA Yaris II Hatchback (XP9) 1.3 VVT-i (SCP90_)


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REPLACEMENT: HEADLIGHTS – TOYOTA VIOS / YARIS II SALOON (XP9). TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Electronic spray
- Drive socket # 10
- Clip removal tool

- Ratchet wrench
- Phillips screwdriver
- Painter's tape

Buy tools

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Replacement: headlights – TOYOTA Vios / Yaris II Saloon (XP9). Tip from AUTODOC:

- The replacement procedure is identical for the right and left headlight.
- Please note: all work on the car TOYOTA Vios / Yaris II Saloon (XP9) should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

- Open the hood.
- Lift the car using a jack or place it over an inspection pit.
- Unscrew the lower fasteners of the bumper. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.



Remove the side bumper retainer clips. Use a Phillips screwdriver. Use a clip removal tool.



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Detach the lockers at the points where they are fastened to the bumper.



- 6 Lower the car.
- Remove the upper bumper retainer clips. Use a clip removal tool.



Stick painter's tape to the car fenders to protect the paintwork from damage when demounting the bumper.



Release the side clips of the bumper.

Carefully release the bumper from the fasteners.

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11 Remove the bumper.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: headlights TOYOTA Vios / Yaris II Saloon (XP9). To avoid damaging the part when removing it, do not use excessive force.
- Unscrew the headlight fasteners. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.



Unplug the connectors of the headlight bulbs.



14 Remove the headlight.



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






AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: headlights – TOYOTA Vios / Yaris II Saloon (XP9). Do not use excessive force when removing the part as this may damage it.





Treat the connectors of the headlights. Use electronic spray.



Plug in the connectors of the headlight bulbs.



18 Install the new headlight.



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AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: headlights TOYOTA Vios / Yaris II Saloon (XP9). To avoid damaging the part during installation, do not use excessive force.
- Screw in the headlight fasteners. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.



- Switch on the ignition.
- Check whether the headlights function properly.



- Switch off the ignition.
- 23 Install the bumper to the mounting seat.



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






AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: headlights – TOYOTA Vios / Yaris II Saloon (XP9). Do not use excessive force during installation. This may damage the part.





Install the upper bumper retainer clips.



- Lift the car using a jack or place it over an inspection pit.
- 27 Install the side bumper retainer clips.



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Attach the lockers at the points where they are fastened to the bumper.



Remove the masking tape.



Screw in the lower fasteners of the bumper. Use a drive socket #10. Use a ratchet wrench.



- Lower the car.
- Close the hood.



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
