REPLACEMENT: AIR FILTER – TOYOTA YARIS III VAN (XP13). TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Hose clamp pliers with retainer
- Microfibre towel

Fender cover

Buy tools

Replacement: air filter – TOYOTA Yaris III Van (XP13). Tip from AUTODOC:

- Follow the terms, recommendations and requirements of the part operation provided by the manufacturer.
- Warning! Shut down the engine before starting any work TOYOTA Yaris III Van (XP13).

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

- Open the bonnet.
- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Remove the fastening clamps of the air filter breather pipe and the air filter inlet pipe. Use hose clamp pliers with retainer.



Release the air filter cover clips.

Take off the filter lid.



Disconnect the air intake pipe from the air filter housing.



Cover the throttle body with a microfibre towel to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the system.



Remove the filter element from the filter housing.



Clean the air filter cover and housing.

Insert a new filter element into the filter housing. Make sure that the filter edge fits tight to the housing.



Replacement: air filter – TOYOTA Yaris III Van (XP13). Professionals recommend:

- Check out the correct location of the filter element. Do not skew.
- Attention! Use quality filters TOYOTA Yaris III Van (XP13).
- During installation, make sure to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the air filter housing.
- Remove the microfibre towel from the throttle body.



Reinstall the air filter cover. Fasten it.

Connect the air intake pipe to the air filter housing.



Press the air filter cover clips into place.



Install the fastening clamps of the air filter breather pipe and the air filter inlet pipe. Use hose clamp pliers with retainer.



- Remove the fender protection cover.
- Close the hood.


