VAUXHALL Astra Mk V (H) (A04) Hatchback 1.4, VAUXHALL Astra Mk V (H) (A04) Hatchback 1.8, VAUXHALL Astra Mk V (H) (A04) Hatchback 2.0 Turbo, VAUXHALL Astra Mk V (H) (A04) Hatchback 1.7 CDTI, VAUXHALL Astra Mk V (H) (A04) Hatchback 1.3 CDTI, VAUXHALL Astra Mk V (H) (A04) Hatchback 1.9 CDTI 16V, VAUXHALL Astra Mk V (H) (A04) Hatchback 1.6, VAUXHALL Astra Mk V (H) (A04) Hatchback 1.6 Turbo

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

REPLACEMENT: COIL SPRINGS – VAUXHALL ASTRA MK V (H) (A04) HATCHBACK. TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Brake cleaner
- Copper grease
- Torque wrench
- Drive socket # E20

- Wheel impact socket #17
- Ratchet wrench
- Tap wrench
- Crow bar
- Hydraulic transmission jack
- Wheel chock

Replacement: coil springs – VAUXHALL Astra Mk V (H) (A04) Hatchback. AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Both coil springs of the rear suspension should be replaced simultaneously.
- The replacement procedure is identical for the left and right coil springs of the rear suspension.
- Please note: all work on the car VAUXHALL Astra Mk V (H) (A04) Hatchback should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

Secure the wheels with chocks.





- Raise the rear of the car and secure on supports.
- Unscrew the wheel bolts.

 Important! Hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts. VAUXHALL Astra Mk V (H) (A04) Hatchback

Remove the wheel.



6 Clean the shock absorber fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



Support the rear suspension beam. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



Unscrew the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a drive socket #E20. Use a tap wrench. Use a ratchet wrench.

Remove the mounting from under the rear axle beam.

- VAUXHALL Astra Mk V (H) (A04) Hatchback Do not lower the transmission jack sharply to avoid damaging components and mechanisms of the car.
- Pull down the rear suspension beam. Use a crowbar.

16 Remove the spring.



Replacement: coil springs – VAUXHALL Astra Mk V (H) (A04) Hatchback. Tip from AUTODOC:

• Inspect the rubber mounts of the suspension spring. Replace if necessary.

Clean the coil spring mounting seats. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



Pull down the rear suspension beam. Use a crowbar.

Install the coil spring together with the rubber mounts into the mounting seats.

20 Support the rear suspension beam. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



21 Install the fastening bolt.

Tighten the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a drive socket #E20. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 130 Nm torque.



Remove the mounting from under the rear axle beam.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: coil springs – VAUXHALL Astra Mk V (H) (A04) Hatchback. Lower the transmission jack smoothly, without jerks, to avoid damaging components and mechanisms.

Remove the mounting from under the rear axle beam.

AUTODOC recommends:

• VAUXHALL Astra Mk V (H) (A04) Hatchback – Do not lower the transmission jack sharply to avoid damaging components and mechanisms of the car.





Clean the wheel rim mounting seat. Use a wire brush.



Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use copper grease.



Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.

Install the wheel.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Important! Hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts. VAUXHALL Astra Mk V (H) (A04) Hatchback

Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.

Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 110 Nm torque.
