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### REPLACEMENT: ANTI ROLL BAR BUSHES - VAUXHALL CORSA MK I (B) HATCHBACK (S93). TOOLS YOU NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Copper grease
- Drive socket # 13

- Ratchet wrench
- Torque wrench
- Hydraulic transmission jack

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### Replacement: anti roll bar bushes – VAUXHALL Corsa Mk I (B) Hatchback (S93). AUTODOC recommends:

- Both stabilizer bushes should be replaced simultaneously.
- The replacement procedure is identical for the right and left stabilizer bushes.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

# REPLACEMENT: ANTI ROLL BAR BUSHES – VAUXHALL CORSA MK I (B) HATCHBACK (S93). USE THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE:

Lift the car using a jack or place it over an inspection pit.



Clean the fasteners of the stabilizer bush brackets. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



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Unscrew the fasteners of the stabilizer bush brackets. Use a drive socket #13. Use a ratchet wrench.



Remove the stabilizer bush brackets.



6 Remove the stabilizer bushes.



- Clean the mounting seats of the stabilizer bushes. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.
- Install the new stabilizer bushes.



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9 Install the stabilizer bush brackets.



Screw the fasteners of the stabilizer bush brackets. Use a drive socket #13. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 20 nm torque.



- Treat the fasteners of the stabilizer bush brackets. Use copper grease.
- Lower the car.



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
