How to change fuel filter on VOLVO C70 I Coupe (872) – replacement guide

This replacement procedure can be used for: VOLVO C70 I Coupe (872) 2.0 T, VOLVO C70 I Coupe (872) 2.0, VOLVO C70 I Coupe (872) 2.3 T-5, VOLVO C70 I Coupe (872) 2.4 T, VOLVO C70 I Coupe (872) 2.4

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.



## REPLACEMENT: FUEL FILTER - VOLVO C70 I COUPE (872). TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- All-purpose cleaning spray
- Drive socket # 12
- Ratchet wrench

- Torque wrench
- Fluid container
- Fuel line pliers
- Flat Screwdriver
- Crow bar

### Replacement: fuel filter - VOLVO C70 I Coupe (872). AUTODOC recommends:

- Ensure adequate ventilation of the workplace. Fuel vapors are poisonous.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

# REPLACEMENT: FUEL FILTER – VOLVO C70 I COUPE (872). RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:

- Open the fuel door.
- 2 Unscrew the fuel filler cap.
- Lift the car using a jack or place it over an inspection pit.
- 4 Prepare a container for fluids.

Clean the fasteners of the fuel supply lines. Use a wire brush. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.

6 Clean the fuel filter bracket. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



7 Unscrew the cap of the pressure control valve.



Press on the pressure control valve. Use a flat screwdriver.



Squeeze the clips and detach the fuel supply lines from the fuel filter housing. Use fuel line pliers. Use a crowbar.

Replacement: fuel filter – VOLVO C70 I Coupe (872). Professionals recommend:

• Be careful! Fuel may leak from the filter housing and hoses.

Unscrew the fuel filter bracket fixing bolts. Use a drive socket #12. Use a ratchet wrench.



Remove the fuel filter together with its bracket.



Remove the fuel filter.



- Put the old filter cartridge in the container.
- 14 Install a new fuel filter.

15 Install the new fuel filter together with its bracket.



Screw the fixing bolts of the fuel filter bracket. Use a drive socket #12. Use a ratchet wrench.



## Replacement: fuel filter – VOLVO C70 I Coupe (872). AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Make sure that the fuel filter is positioned correctly. Consider the fuel flow direction mark.
- During installation, take care to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the fuel filter housing.
- Take care to only use quality filters.
- Connect the fuel lines to the fuel filter and lock the fastening clips.
  - Tighten the fuel filter fasteners. Use a drive socket #12. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 25 Nm torque.

Screw on the cap of the pressure control valve.



Take the fluid container away from under the fuel filter.



- 21 Lower the car.
- Tighten the fuel filler cap.
- Close the fuel door.

### Replacement: fuel filter – VOLVO C70 I Coupe (872). AUTODOC recommends:

- Before starting off, switch the ignition on and off several times. This should be done to activate the fuel pump to make it pump fuel through the fuel system.
- Run the engine for a few minutes. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.
- Shut off the engine.

• To protect the environment from pollution, be sure to dispose of the used filters at special collection points.




