Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for:

VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526) 2.0 T4, VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526) 1.6 T3 GTDi, VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526) 1.6 T4 GTDi, VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526) 1.6 D2, VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526) 2.0 D3, VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526) 2.0 D4, VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526) 2.5 T5, VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526) 2.0 T5, VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526) 1.6 D4, VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526) 1.6 T4, VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526) T5, VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526) T2, VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526) T3, VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526) 2.0 D2, VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526) D4 Polestar, (+ 1)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

REPLACEMENT: BRAKE PADS – VOLVO V40
HATCHBACK (525, 526). LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL
NEED:



- Brake cleaner
- Anti-squeal paste
- Copper grease
- HEX bit no.H7.
- Wheel impact socket #19
- Brake caliper wind back tool
- Ratchet wrench
- Torque wrench
- Rubber mallet
- Crow bar
- Wheel chock

Buy tools

Replacement: brake pads – VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526). AUTODOC experts recommend:

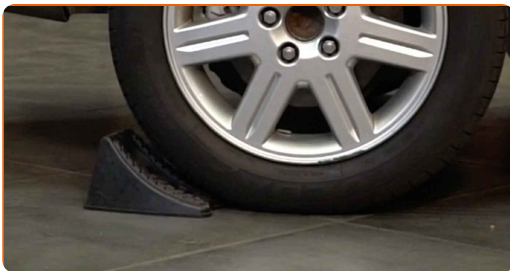
- Perform the replacement of brake pads in complete set for each axis. This provides effective braking.
- The replacement procedure is identical for all brake pads on the same axle.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: BRAKE PADS – VOLVO V40 HATCHBACK (525, 526). USE THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE:

1 Open the bonnet. Unscrew the brake fluid reservoir cap.



2 Secure the wheels with chocks.



3 Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19.



4 Raise the rear of the car and secure on supports.

5 Unscrew the wheel bolts.



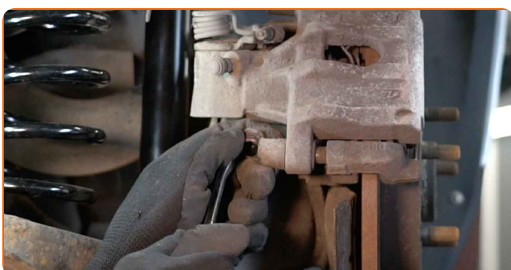
AUTODOC recommends:

- Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts.
VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526)

6 Remove the wheel.



7 Remove the dust boot caps of the brake caliper guide pins. Use a crowbar.

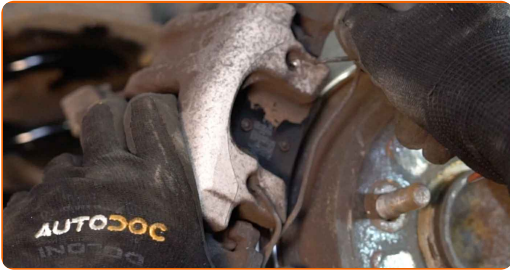


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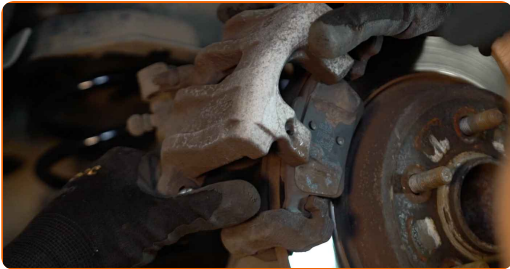
Unscrew the brake caliper fastening. Use HEX No.H7. Use a ratchet wrench.

Detach the brake caliper retaining spring. Use a crowbar.

**10**

Remove the brake caliper. Use a crowbar.



Replacement: brake pads – VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526). Professionals recommend:

- Tie the caliper to the suspension or to the body with a wire without disconnecting from the brake hose to prevent depressurization of the brake system.
- Make sure that the brake caliper is not hanging on the brake hose.
- Don't press the brake pedal after the brake caliper has been removed. As a result, the piston can fall out from the brake cylinder, and brake fluid leakage and depressurization of the system may occur.
- Check the brake caliper bracket, brake caliper guide pins and boots. Clean them. Replace, if necessary.

Remove the brake pads. Use a crowbar.



Replacement: brake pads – VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526). Tip from AUTODOC:

- Measure the brake disc thickness. Upon reaching the wear limit the part must be replaced.

Treat the brake caliper piston. Use a brake cleaner.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: brake pads – VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526). After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

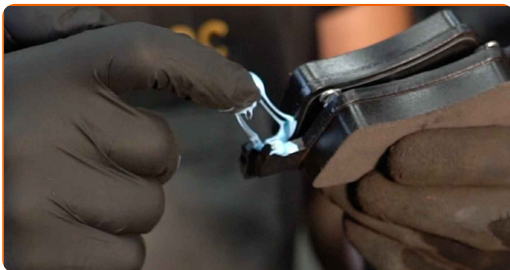

Press in the brake caliper piston. Use brake caliper wind back tool.

Treat the brake pads in the area where their surface comes into contact with the brake caliper bracket. Use anti-squeal paste.



Replacement: brake pads – VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526). Tip:

- Make sure the disc surface is clean before installing the pads.

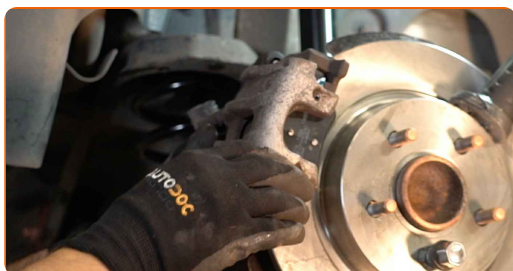
15 Install new brake pads.



Replacement: brake pads – VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526). AUTODOC recommends:

- Make sure the pads are installed with linings facing the disc.

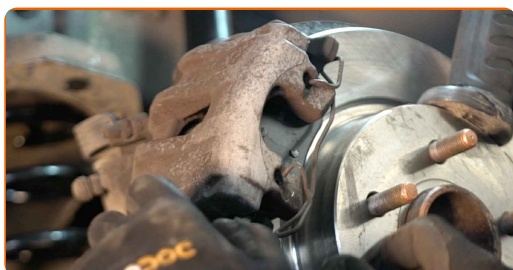
16 Install the brake caliper and fix it. Use HEX No.H7. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 35 Nm torque.



17 Install the dust boot caps of the brake caliper guide pins.

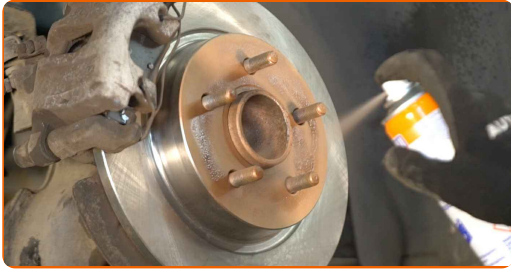


18 Install the brake caliper retaining spring. Use a rubber mallet.

Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use copper grease.

Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.

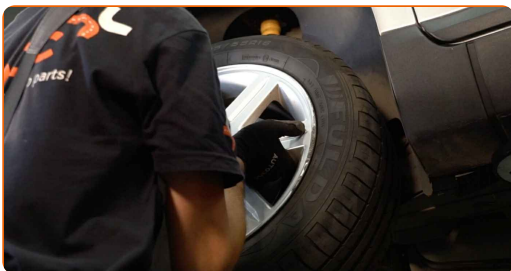


Replacement: brake pads – VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526). Professionals recommend:

- After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

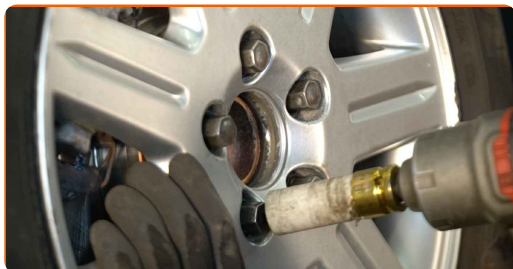
Install the wheel.



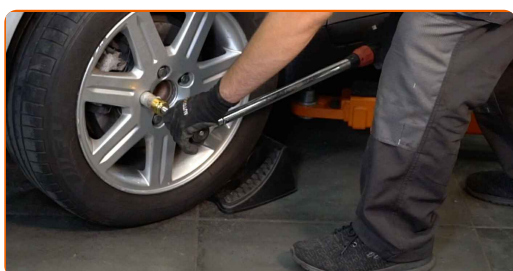
AUTODOC recommends:

- Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts on the car. VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526)

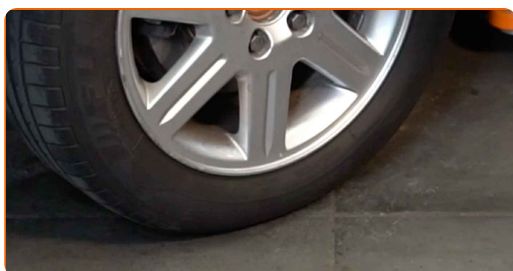
22 Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #19.



23 Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 110 Nm torque.



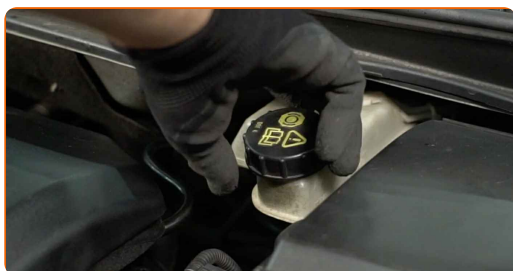
24 Remove the jacks and chocks.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Important! Replacement: brake pads – VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526). Check the brake fluid level in the reservoir and top up if necessary.

25 Tighten the brake fluid reservoir cap.



AUTODOC recommends:

- VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526) – Without starting the engine, press the brake pedal several times until it feels firm.

Close the hood.

Replacement: brake pads – VOLVO V40 Hatchback (525, 526). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Slow down smoothly for first 150-200 km after the brake pads replacement. Avoid unnecessary and sharp braking to a stop.

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
