This replacement procedure can be used for:

VOLVO V60 (155, 157) 2.0 T, VOLVO V60 (155, 157) 2.0 D3 / D4, VOLVO V60 (155, 157) 2.4 D5, VOLVO V60 (155, 157) 2.4 D5 AWD, VOLVO V60 (155, 157) 1.6 T3, VOLVO V60 (155, 157) 1.6 T4, VOLVO V60 (155, 157) 2.0 T5, VOLVO V60 (155, 157) 3.0 T6 AWD, VOLVO V60 (155, 157) 1.6 DRIVe, VOLVO V60 (155, 157) 1.6 T4F, VOLVO V60 (155, 157) 2.4 Hybrid D6 AWD, VOLVO V60 (155, 157) 2.0 D3, VOLVO V60 (155, 157) 2.4 D4 AWD, VOLVO V60 (155, 157) 2.0 D4, VOLVO V60 (155, 157) 2.0 T6, (+ 14)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

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








REPLACEMENT: POLLEN FILTER – VOLVO V60 (155, 157). TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Torx bit T25
- Drive socket #8

Ratchet wrench

Buy tools

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Replacement: pollen filter – VOLVO V60 (155, 157). AUTODOC recommends:

- Replace the cabin filter at least once every six months, in early spring and autumn seasons.
- Follow the terms, recommendations and requirements of the part operation provided by the manufacturer.
- If the air flow into the cabin has sharply reduced, replace the filter before a scheduled maintenance.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: POLLEN FILTER – VOLVO V60 (155, 157). USE THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE:

1 Open the car door.

Remove the floor mat from the passenger side.



Bend back the floor liner on the passenger's side.



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4 Unscrew the fasteners of the passenger side kick panel. Use Torx T25.



Move the lower glove box cover aside.



6 Detach the fuse box and move it aside.



Open the glove box.

Unscrew the glove box mounting screws. Use Torx T25. Use a drive socket #8. Use a ratchet wrench.



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9 Remove the side panel on the passenger side.



10 Remove the glove box.



Detach the glove box connectors.



Remove the cabin filter housing cover.



13 Remove the cabin filter.



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Replacement: pollen filter – VOLVO V60 (155, 157). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

• Do not attempt to clean and reuse the filter – this will reduce the quality of cabin air filtration.

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Install a new cabin filter according to the air flow direction mark.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Look at the marks on the new filter. They may indicate the air flow direction, which should be considered when installing the part.

Install the cabin filter housing cover.



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Reattach the glove box connectors.



17 Install the glove box.



Screw in the glove box mounting screws. Use Torx T25. Use a drive socket #8. Use a ratchet wrench.



19 Install the side panel on the passenger side.



Close the glove box.



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Reinstall the fuse box.



Install and secure the cover under the glove box.



Screw in the fasteners of the passenger side kick panel. Use Torx T25.



Put the passenger's side floor liner back.



Return the floor mat to the original position.

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- Close the car door. 26
- Switch on the ignition. 27
- Switch on the air conditioning system. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates 28 properly.
- Switch off the ignition.
