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
How to change front lower arm on **VW Bora Saloon** – replacement guide

This video shows the replacement procedure of a similar car part on another vehicle

i Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for: VW Bora Saloon 2.0

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: VW Golf IV Hatchback (1J1) 1.6

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REPLACEMENT: FRONT LOWER ARM – VW BORA SALOON. TOOLS YOU NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Brake cleaner
- Copper grease
- Combination spanner #18
- Drive socket # 13
- Drive socket # 16
- Drive socket # 18

- Wheel impact socket #17
- Ratchet wrench
- Torque wrench
- Tap wrench
- Crow bar
- Hydraulic transmission jack
- Wheel chock

Buy tools

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Replacement: front lower arm – VW Bora Saloon. Tip from AUTODOC:

- The replacement procedure is identical for the left and right lower control arms.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: FRONT LOWER ARM – VW BORA SALOON. RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:

- Secure the wheels with chocks.
- Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



- Raise the front of the car and secure on supports.
- 4 Unscrew the wheel bolts.



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AUTODOC recommends:

 Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts. VW Bora Saloon

Remove the wheel.

Clean all joints of the arm. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: front lower arm VW Bora Saloon. After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.
- Wear protective goggles.

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7 Unscrew the fastener connecting the stabilizer bar with the control arm. Use a drive socket #16. Use a tap wrench.



Unscrew the fastener connecting the ball joint to the suspension control arm. Use a drive socket #13. Use a tap wrench.



Loosen the front fastener of the control arm. Use a drive socket #18. Use a tap wrench.



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Unscrew the rear arm fastener. Use a combination spanner #18. Use a drive socket #18. Use a tap wrench.



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Remove the rear fastener of the control arm.



Unscrew the front arm fastener. Use a drive socket #18. Use a ratchet wrench.



Remove the front fastener of the control arm.



Disconnect the spherical joint from the arm.



Remove the arm. Use a crowbar.



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Clean the mounting seats and the thread of the suspension arm. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



17 Install a new arm.



Replacement: front lower arm – VW Bora Saloon. AUTODOC experts recommend:

- During the installation process, use only new bolts and nuts.
- Do not damage the ball joint cover.

Install the control arm fasteners.

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Attach the ball joint to the control arm.



Screw the fasteners of the ball joint. Use a drive socket #13. Use a ratchet wrench.



Support the arm. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



Tighten the front fastener connecting the control arm to the subframe. Use a drive socket #18. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 70 Nm torque.+90°



AUTODOC recommends:

• Important! Be sure to use new fasteners.

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Tighten the rear fastener of the control arm. Use a drive socket #18. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 70 Nm torque.+90°



AUTODOC recommends:

• Important! Be sure to use new fasteners.

Remove the support from under the arm.



AUTODOC recommends:

• VW Bora Saloon – Do not lower the transmission jack sharply to avoid damaging components and mechanisms of the car.

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Tighten the fastener connecting the stabilizer bar with the control arm. Use a drive socket #16. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 15 Nm torque.+90°



AUTODOC recommends:

• Important! Be sure to use new fasteners.

Tighten the ball joint fastener. Use a drive socket #13. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 20 Nm torque.+90°



AUTODOC recommends:

• Important! Be sure to use new fasteners.

Treat all joints of the arm. Use copper grease.

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Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use copper grease.



Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: front lower arm – VW Bora Saloon. After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

Install the wheel.



AUTODOC recommends:

• Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts on the car. VW Bora Saloon

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Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 120 nm torque.



Remove the jacks and chocks.





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
