This video shows the replacement procedure of a similar car part on another vehicle

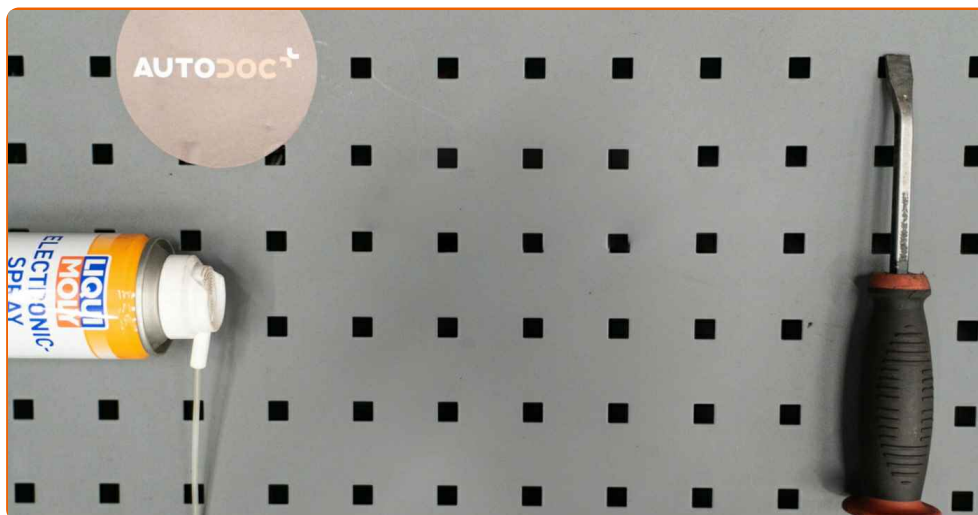
### **i Important!**

This replacement procedure can be used for:  
VW GOLF I Cabriolet (155) 1.8

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: VW GOLF II (19E, 1G1) 1.6

## REPLACEMENT: DISTRIBUTOR CAP – VW GOLF I CABRIOLET (155). TOOLS YOU NEED:



- Electronic spray
- Fender cover
- Crow bar

### Replacement: distributor cap – VW GOLF I Cabriolet (155). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

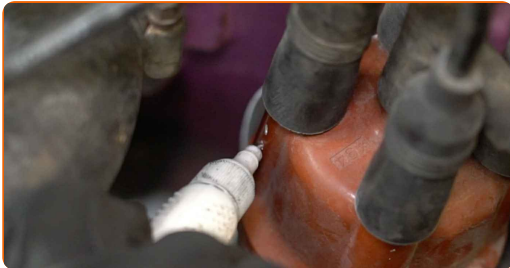
- Follow the terms, recommendations and requirements of the part operation provided by the manufacturer.
- Thoroughly inspect the ignition distributor assembly. Replace any worn parts.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

## REPLACEMENT: DISTRIBUTOR CAP – VW GOLF I CABRIOLET (155). USE THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE:

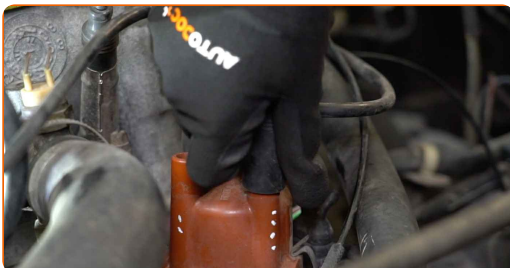
1 Open the hood.

2 Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.

3 Make marks on the distributor cap to indicate the installation order of the spark plug wires.



4 Disconnect the spark plug wires from the distributor cap.

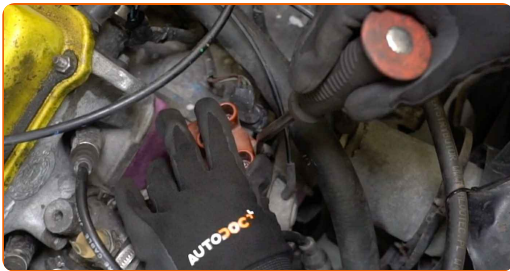


Replacement: distributor cap – VW GOLF I Cabriolet (155). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Be careful to avoid damaging spark plug wires.

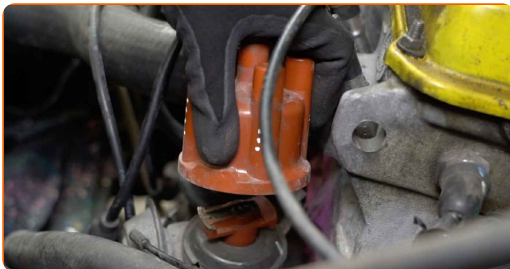

Release the distributor cap clips. Use a crowbar.

Remove the distributor cap.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: distributor cap – VW GOLF I Cabriolet (155). Do not use excessive force when removing the part as this may damage it.

Install a new distributor cap.



### AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: distributor cap – VW GOLF I Cabriolet (155). Do not use excessive force during installation. This may damage the part.

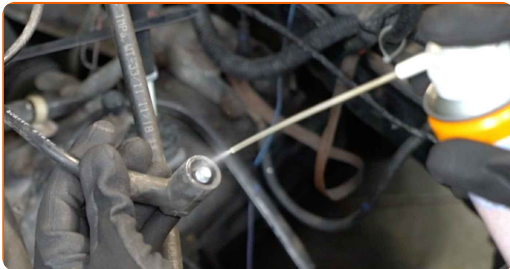

Fasten the distributor cap clips.



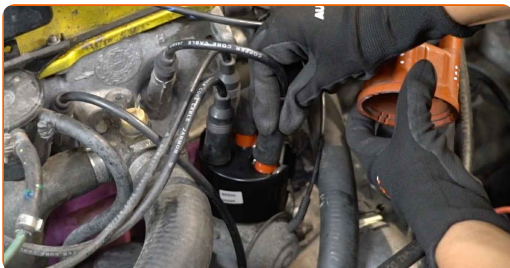

Treat the spark plug wire connectors. Use dielectric grease.

Connect the spark plug wires to the distributor cap.



### Replacement: distributor cap – VW GOLF I Cabriolet (155). Tip:

- Follow the installation sequence.

- 11** Run the engine for a few minutes. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.
- 12** Shut off the engine.
- 13** Remove the fender protection cover.
- 14** Close the hood.
