This replacement procedure can be used for:

VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 1.6 BiFuel, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 1.6 TDI, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 1.2 TSI, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 1.4 16V, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 1.6 FSI, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 1.9 TDI, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 2.0 TDI 16V, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 2.0 FSI, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 1.6, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 2.0 TDI, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 1.4 TSI, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 1.4 FSI, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 1.6 MultiFuel

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: VW Passat B7 Saloon (362) 2.0 TDI

Replacement: pollen filter – VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521). AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Replace the cabin filter at least once every six months, in early spring and autumn seasons.
- Follow the terms, recommendations and requirements of the part operation provided by the manufacturer.
- If the air flow into the cabin has sharply reduced, replace the filter before a scheduled maintenance.
- Please note: all work on the car – VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) – should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

1 Move the passenger seat fully backwards.

2 Unscrew the fasteners of the bottom trim panel.



3 Remove the bottom cover of the glove box.

Remove the cabin filter housing cover.



5

Remove the cabin filter.



Replacement: pollen filter – VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Do not attempt to clean and reuse the filter - it will affect the quality of air cleaning inside the car.

Install the cabin filter to its mounting seat.



Replacement: pollen filter – VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521). AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Follow the air flow direction arrow on the filter.
- Check out the correct location of the filter element. Do not skew.
- Attention! Use quality filters – VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521).

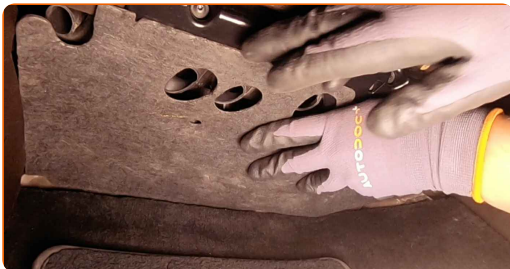

Reinstall the cabin filter housing cover. Position the part using the guides and lock the fasteners.



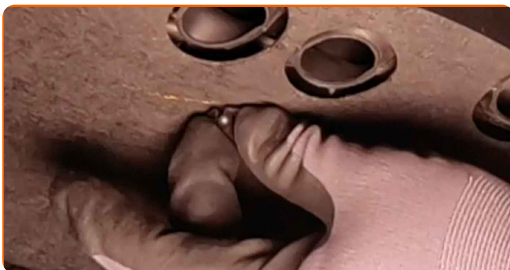

Install the bottom cover of the glove box.



9

Screw in the fasteners of the bottom trim panel.



10 Return the passenger seat to its initial position.

11 Switch on the ignition.

12 Switch on the air conditioning system. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.



13 Switch off the ignition.
