VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 1.6 BiFuel, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 1.6 TDI, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 1.2 TSI, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 1.4 16V, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 1.6 FSI, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 1.9 TDI, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 2.0 TDI 16V, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 2.0 FSI, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 1.6, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 1.4 TSI, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 1.4 TSI, VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521) 1.6 MultiFuel

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

### REPLACEMENT: SHOCK ABSORBERS – VW GOLF PLUS / CROSSGOLF (5M1, 521). TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Combination spanner #16
- Combination spanner #21
- Drive socket # 16
- Drive socket # 21

- Hydraulic transmission jack
- Copper grease
- Adjustable wrench
- Torque wrench
- Wheel impact socket #17
- Wheel chock

### Replacement: shock absorbers – VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521). Tip from AUTODOC:

- Both shock absorbers of the rear suspension should be replaced simultaneously.
- The replacement procedure is identical for the left and right shock absorbers of the rear suspension.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

#### CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

Secure the wheels with chocks.

Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



Raise the rear of the car and secure on supports.

Unscrew the wheel bolts.



#### AUTODOC recommends:

- Important! Hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts. VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521)
- 5 Remove the wheel.



- 6 Support the arm. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.
- Clean the fasteners of the shock absorber upper mount. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.

Unscrew the shock absorber mount fastening. Use a drive socket #16.



Unscrew the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a combination spanner #21.



Replacement: shock absorbers – VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521).

AUTODOC recommends:

- To avoid injuries, hold the shock absorber when undoing the fastening bolts.
- 10 Remove the support from under the rear arm.



11 Remove the shock absorber.

Remove the protective cap of the shock absorber mount.



Remove the shock absorber piston rod fastening. Use a combination spanner #16. Use an adjustable wrench.



Remove the shock absorber mount, boot and bump stop.



#### **AUTODOC** recommends:

- Before installing a new shock absorber you should pump it manually 3-5 times.
- Replacement: shock absorbers VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521). Carefully
  inspect the mount, the boot, and the bump stop of the shock absorber. Replace if
  necessary.

15 Install the boot and a bump stop onto the shock absorber.



16 Install the shock absorber upper mount.



Screw the shock strut piston rod upper fastening. Use a combination spanner #16. Use an adjustable wrench. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 25 Nm torque.



Clean the shock absorber mounting seats. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.

Place the shock absorber in the wheel arch and secure it.



- Support the arm. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.
- Install the shock absorber mount using the center hole as a guide.



Tighten the shock absorber mount fasteners. Important! Be sure to use new fasteners. Use a drive socket #16. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 50 Nm torque.+45°



Tighten the lower fastener of the shock absorber. Use a drive socket #21. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 180 Nm torque.

Remove the support from under the rear arm. 24



Clean the wheel rim mounting seat. Use a wire brush. 25.1



Treat the contacting surface. Use copper grease. 25.2



Install the wheel. 26



Replacement: shock absorbers – VW Golf Plus / Crossgolf (5M1, 521). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

• To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when screwing in the fastening bolts.

Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 120 Nm torque.



Remove the jacks and chocks.
