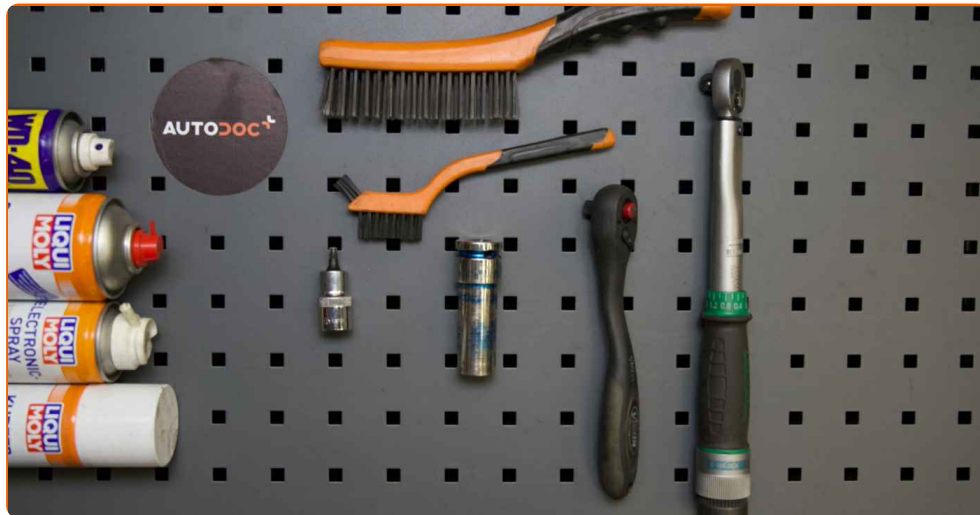
This replacement procedure can be used for:

VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 1.4 16V, VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 2.0 TDI 16V, VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 2.0 FSI, VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 1.9 TDI, VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 1.6 FSI, VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 1.4 FSI, VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 2.0 SDI, VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 1.6, VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 1.9 TDI 4motion, VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 2.0 TDI 16V 4motion, VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 2.0 FSI 4motion, VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 2.0 GTI, VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 2.0 TDI, VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 1.4 TSI, VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 3.2 R32 4motion, (+ 3)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

**REPLACEMENT: ABS SENSOR – VW GOLF V HATCHBACK (1K1). LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:**



- Wire brush
- Nylon cleaning brush
- WD-40 spray
- Brake cleaner
- Electronic spray
- Multipurpose grease
- Copper grease
- Torque wrench
- HEX bit No.H5
- Wheel impact socket #17
- Ratchet wrench
- Flat screwdriver
- Wheel chock

**Buy tools**

Replacement: ABS sensor – VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1). AUTODOC experts recommend:

- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

## REPLACEMENT: ABS SENSOR – VW GOLF V HATCHBACK (1K1). USE THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE:

**1** Secure the wheels with chocks.

**2** Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



**3** Raise the front of the car and secure on supports.

**4** Unscrew the wheel bolts.



### AUTODOC recommends:

- Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts. VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1)

**5** Remove the wheel.



**6** Detach the ABS sensor connector.



**7** Clean the ABS sensor fastener. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



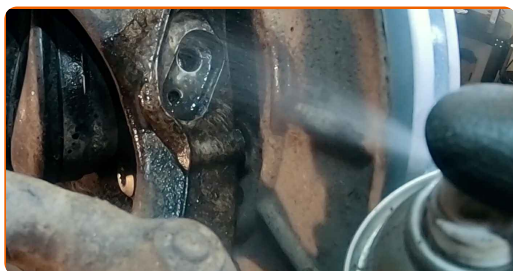
**8** Unscrew the ABS sensor fastener. Use HEX No.H5. Use a ratchet wrench.



**9** Disconnect the ABS sensor.



**10** Clean the ABS sensor mounting seat. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



**11** Treat the ABS sensor fastener. Use a multipurpose grease. Use a flat screwdriver.



**12** Connect the ABS sensor.



**13** Tighten the fastener that connects the ABS sensor to the steering knuckle. Use HEX No.H5. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 7 Nm torque.



**14** Treat the ABS sensor connector. Use a nylon cleaning brush. Use dielectric grease.



**15** Attach the ABS sensor connector.



**16** Clean the wheel rim mounting seat. Use a wire brush.



**17** Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use copper grease.

Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.



**AUTODOC recommends:**

- Replacement: ABS sensor – VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1). After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

Install the wheel.



**AUTODOC recommends:**

- Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts on the car. VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1)

20

Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.





**21** Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 120 Nm torque.

**22** Remove the jacks and chocks.
