This replacement procedure can be used for: VW ILTIS (183) 1.6 TD

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: VW Transporter IV Minibus (70B, 70C, 7DB, 7DK, 70J, 70K, 7DC, 7DJ) 2.5 TDI

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REPLACEMENT: FUEL FILTER - VW ILTIS (183). LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Phillips screwdriver
- Flat Screwdriver

Fender cover

Buy tools

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Replacement: fuel filter – VW ILTIS (183). AUTODOC recommends:

- Ensure adequate ventilation of the workplace. Fuel vapors are poisonous.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: FUEL FILTER – VW ILTIS (183). RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:

- 1 Open the bonnet.
- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Remove the battery cover.



- Remove the retainers of the fasteners of the fuel filter tubes. Use a flat screwdriver.
- Loosen the fastening clamps of the fuel filter pipes. Use a Phillips screwdriver. Use a flat screwdriver.



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6 Detach the tubes from the fuel filter.



Replacement: fuel filter – VW ILTIS (183). Professionals recommend:

• Be careful! Fuel may leak from the filter housing and hoses.

Remove the fuel filter.



Install a new fuel filter.

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Replacement: fuel filter – VW ILTIS (183). AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Make sure that the fuel filter is positioned correctly. Consider the fuel flow direction mark.
- During installation, take care to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the fuel filter housing.
- Take care to only use quality filters.
- Attach the tubes to the fuel filter.



- Tighten the fastening clamps of the fuel filter pipes. Use a Phillips screwdriver.
- Install the retainers of the fasteners of the fuel filter tubes.



12 Install the battery cover.



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- Remove the fender protection cover.
- Close the hood.
- Run the engine for a few minutes. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.
- Shut off the engine.

Replacement: fuel filter – VW ILTIS (183). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Before the start be sure to bleed the fuel system to prevent the air inleakage.
- To protect the environment from pollution, be sure to dispose of the used filters at special collection points.



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
