How to change serpentine belt on VW PASSAT (3B2) – replacement guide

This video shows the replacement procedure of a similar car part on another vehicle

i Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for: VW PASSAT (3B2) 1.6, VW PASSAT (3B2) 1.8, VW PASSAT (3B2) 1.8 T, VW PASSAT (3B2) 1.8 Syncro/4motion, VW PASSAT (3B2) 2.0

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

REPLACEMENT: SERPENTINE BELT – VW PASSAT (3B2). TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Combination spanner #17
- HEX bit No.H5
- HEX bit No.H7

- Ratchet wrench
- Fender cover

AUTODOC recommends:

• All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: SERPENTINE BELT – VW PASSAT (3B2). RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:

- Open the hood.
- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Unscrew the engine cover fastener. Use HEX No.H5. Use a ratchet wrench.



Remove the engine cover.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: serpentine belt – VW PASSAT (3B2). Do not use excessive force when removing the part as this may damage it.

- Lift the car using a jack or place it over an inspection pit.
- Loosen the fastener of the AC compressor belt tensioner pulley. Use HEX No.H7. Use a ratchet wrench.



7 Remove the V belt.

Replacement: serpentine belt – VW PASSAT (3B2). Professionals recommend:

- Check the condition of the tensioner pulley and idler pulley. Replace them if necessary.
- Pull aside the V-ribbed belt tensioner pulley. Use a combination spanner #17.



Remove the V-ribbed belt.

Replacement: serpentine belt – VW PASSAT (3B2). Tip:

 Check the condition of the tensioner pulley and idler pulley. Replace them if necessary.

Return the tensioner pulley to its initial position.



Install the V-ribbed belt.

Pull aside the V-ribbed belt tensioner pulley. Use a combination spanner #17.



Place the serpentine belt on the crankshaft pulley.

Replacement: serpentine belt – VW PASSAT (3B2). AUTODOC recommends:

- Make sure that the V-ribbed belt fits all pulleys snugly.
- Make sure that the V-ribbed belt is properly tensioned.

14 Install the V belt.



- Screw in the fastener of the AC compressor belt tensioner pulley. Use a combination spanner #17. Use HEX No.H7. Use a ratchet wrench.
 - Lower the car.
 - Return the tensioner pulley to its initial position. Use a combination spanner #17.



Install the engine cover and secure it.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Make sure the engine cover is properly seated. It should not be displaced with respect to the guiding fasteners.
- When installing, do not use excessive force to avoid damage to the part.

Screw in the engine cover fasteners. Use HEX No.H5. Use a ratchet wrench.



- Remove the fender protection cover.
- Close the hood.
