

How to change rear brake pads on VW Passat B3/B4 Saloon (3A2, 35i) – replacement guide

This video shows the replacement procedure of a similar car part on another vehicle

This replacement procedure can be used for:


VW Passat B3/B4 Saloon (3A2, 35i) 2.0, VW Passat B3/B4 Saloon (3A2, 35i) 1.9 TDI, VW Passat B3/B4 Saloon (3A2, 35i) 2.8 VR6, VW Passat B3/B4 Saloon (3A2, 35i) 2.0 16V

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: VW Golf V Hatchback (1K1) 1.6











Replacement: brake pads – VW Passat B3/B4 Saloon (3A2, 35i). AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Perform the replacement of brake pads in complete set for each axis. This provides effective braking.
- The replacement procedure is identical for all brake pads on the same axle.
- Please note: all work on the car VW Passat B3/B4 Saloon (3A2, 35i) should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:



Open the bonnet. Unscrew the brake fluid reservoir cap.



Secure the wheels with chocks.

Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.

Raise the rear of the car and secure on supports.





5

Unscrew the wheel bolts.



AUTODOC recommends:

• Important! Hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts. VW Passat B3/B4 Saloon (3A2, 35i)

Remove the wheel.



7

Clean the brake caliper fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



8

Unscrew the brake caliper fastening. Use a combination spanner #13.







9

Remove the brake caliper. Use a crowbar.



Replacement: brake pads - VW Passat B3/B4 Saloon (3A2, 35i). Tip:

- Tie the caliper to the suspension or to the body with a wire without disconnecting from the brake hose to prevent depressurization of the brake system.
- Make sure that the brake caliper is not hanging on the brake hose.
- Don't press the brake pedal after the brake caliper has been removed. As a result, the piston can fall out from the brake cylinder, and brake fluid leakage and depressurization of the system may occur.
- Check the brake caliper bracket, brake caliper guide pins and boots. Clean them. Replace, if necessary.
- Remove the brake pads.



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Replacement: brake pads – VW Passat B3/B4 Saloon (3A2, 35i). AUTODOC recommends:

• Measure the brake disc thickness. Upon reaching the wear limit the part must be replaced.

Treat the brake caliper piston. Use a brake cleaner.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: brake pads – VW Passat B3/B4 Saloon (3A2, 35i). After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.



Press in the brake caliper piston. Use brake caliper wind back tool.

Clean the brake caliper bracket from dirt and dust. Use a wire brush. Use a brake cleaner.



Replacement: brake pads – VW Passat B3/B4 Saloon (3A2, 35i). Tip from AUTODOC:

• After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

Treat the brake pads in the area where their surface comes into contact with the brake caliper bracket. Use antisqueal paste.



AUTODOC recommends:

• Make sure the disc surface is clean before installing the pads.

15

Install new brake pads.







Replacement: brake pads – VW Passat B3/B4 Saloon (3A2, 35i). AUTODOC experts recommend:

• Make sure the pads are installed with linings facing the disc.

16

Install the brake caliper and fix it. Use a drive socket #13. Use a combination spanner #13. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 35 Nm torque.



17

Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use copper grease.



18

Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.



AUTODOC recommends:

 Replacement: brake pads – VW Passat B3/B4 Saloon (3A2, 35i). After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.







Install the wheel.



AUTODOC recommends:

• Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts on the car. VW Passat B3/B4 Saloon (3A2, 35i)

Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



21

Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 120 Nm torque.





Remove the jacks and chocks.







Replacement: brake pads – VW Passat B3/B4 Saloon (3A2, 35i). Tip from AUTODOC experts:

• Check the brake fluid level in the expansion tank and refill if necessary.

Tighten the brake fluid reservoir cap.



Replacement: brake pads – VW Passat B3/B4 Saloon (3A2, 35i). AUTODOC recommends:

• Without starting the engine, press the brake pedal several times until you feel significant resistance.

Close the hood.

AUTODOC recommends:

• Slow down smoothly for first 150-200 km after the brake pads replacement. Avoid unneccessary and sharp braking to a stop.




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
