How to change rear coil springs on **VW Passat Saloon (3C2)** – replacement guide

This replacement procedure can be used for:

VW Passat Saloon (3C2) 1.6 FSI, VW Passat Saloon (3C2) 2.0 FSI, VW Passat Saloon (3C2) 1.9 TDI, VW Passat Saloon (3C2) 2.0 TDI 16V, VW Passat Saloon (3C2) 2.0 TDI, VW Passat Saloon (3C2) 1.6, VW Passat Saloon (3C2) 3.2 FSI 4motion, VW Passat Saloon (3C2) 2.0 FSI 4motion, VW Passat Saloon (3C2) 2.0 TDI 4motion, VW Passat Saloon (3C2) 1.4 TSI, VW Passat Saloon (3C2) 1.8 TSI, VW Passat Saloon (3C2) 2.0 BlueTDI, VW Passat Saloon (3C2) 1.6 TDI

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

#### REPLACEMENT: COIL SPRINGS – VW PASSAT SALOON (3C2). LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Brake cleaner
- Copper grease
- Combination spanner #18
- Drive socket # 18

- Wheel impact socket #17
- Ratchet wrench
- Torque wrench
- Crow bar
- Hydraulic transmission jack
- Wheel chock

- Both coil springs of the rear suspension should be replaced simultaneously.
- The replacement procedure is identical for the left and right coil springs of the rear suspension.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

## REPLACEMENT: COIL SPRINGS – VW PASSAT SALOON (3C2). RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:



- Secure the wheels with chocks.

Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.

Raise the rear of the car and secure on supports.

Unscrew the wheel bolts.

Support the arm. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



10

Unscrew the fastener connecting the control arm to the rear knuckle. Use a combination spanner #18. Use a drive socket #18. Use a ratchet wrench.



11

Remove the fastening bolt. Use a crowbar.



12

Remove the support from under the arm.





#### AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: coil springs VW Passat Saloon (3C2). Lower the transmission jack smoothly, without jerks, to avoid damaging components and mechanisms.

- Remove the spring.



- 14
- Clean the mounting seats and the thread of the suspension arm. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



- 15
- Clean the coil spring mounting seats. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.





16

Install the coil spring together with the rubber mounts into the mounting seats.



17

Support the arm. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



18

Install the fastening bolt. Use a crowbar.



19

Screw in the fastener connecting the control arm to the rear subframe. Use a combination spanner #18. Use a drive socket #18. Use a ratchet wrench.





20

Remove the support from under the arm.



## Replacement: coil springs – VW Passat Saloon (3C2). AUTODOC experts recommend:

• Lower the hydraulic transmission jack smoothly, without jerks, to avoid damaging assemblies and mechanisms.

21

Support the stub axle. Use a hydraulic transmission jack.



22

Tighten the arm fastening to the beam. Use a combination spanner #18. Use a drive socket #18. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 95 Nm torque.





23

Tighten the fasteners connecting the control arm to the rear knuckle. Use a combination spanner #18. Use a drive socket #18. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 90 Nm torque.+90°



#### AUTODOC recommends:

• Important! Be sure to use new fasteners.



Remove the support from under the stub axle.



#### Replacement: coil springs - VW Passat Saloon (3C2). Tip from AUTODOC:

• Lower the hydraulic transmission jack smoothly, without jerks, to avoid damaging assemblies and mechanisms.

Treat all joints of the arm. Use copper grease.



26

Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use copper grease.



27

Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.



#### AUTODOC recommends:

• Replacement: coil springs – VW Passat Saloon (3C2). After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

28

Install the wheel.





#### Replacement: coil springs – VW Passat Saloon (3C2). Tip:

• To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when screwing in the fastening bolts.

29

Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



30

Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 120 nm torque.

31

Remove the jacks and chocks.
