How to change pollen filter on **VW POLO (AW1, BZ1)** – replacement guide

This video shows the replacement procedure of a similar car part on another vehicle

(i) Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for: VW POLO (AW1, BZ1) 1.0 MPi, VW POLO (AW1, BZ1) 1.6 MPi, VW POLO (AW1, BZ1) 1.5 TSI, VW POLO (AW1, BZ1) 1.0 TSI

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

This tutorial was created based on the replacement procedure for a similar car part on: SEAT Ibiza III Hatchback (6L) 1.4 16V



Replacement: pollen filter – VW POLO (AW1, BZ1). AUTODOC recommends:

- Replace the cabin filter at least once every six months, in early spring and autumn seasons.
- Follow the terms, recommendations and requirements of the part operation provided by the manufacturer.
- If the air flow into the cabin has sharply reduced, replace the filter before a scheduled maintenance.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: POLLEN FILTER – VW POLO (AW1, BZ1). TAKE THE FOLLOWING STEPS:



Move the passenger seat fully backwards.





Remove the bottom cover of the glove box.

Release the cabin filter cover clips.

Remove the cabin filter housing cover

Remove the filter element from the filter housing


• Do not attempt to clean and reuse the filter - it will affect the quality of air cleaning inside the car.

Insert a new filter element into the filter housing. Make sure that the filter edge fits tight to the housing.

Return the passenger seat to its initial position.





Switch on the ignition.

12 Switch on the air conditioning system. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.



Switch off the ignition.
