This replacement procedure can be used for:

VW Transporter T4 Van (70A, 70H, 7DA, 7DH) 2.0, VW Transporter T4 Van (70A, 70H, 7DA, 7DH) 2.5, VW Transporter T4 Van (70A, 70H, 7DA, 7DH) 1.9 TD, VW Transporter T4 Van (70A, 70H, 7DA, 7DH) 2.4 D, VW Transporter T4 Van (70A, 70H, 7DA, 7DH) 2.5 Syncro, VW Transporter T4 Van (70A, 70H, 7DA, 7DH) 2.4 D Syncro, VW Transporter T4 Van (70A, 70H, 7DA, 7DH) 2.5 TDI Syncro, VW Transporter T4 Van (70A, 70H, 7DA, 7DH) 2.8 VR6

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

## REPLACEMENT: AIR FILTER – VW TRANSPORTER T4 VAN (70A, 70H, 7DA, 7DH). LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- HEX bit No.H5
- Water pump pliers

- Microfibre towel
- Fender cover

#### Replacement: air filter – VW Transporter T4 Van (70A, 70H, 7DA, 7DH). Tip:

- Follow the terms, recommendations and requirements of the part operation provided by the manufacturer.
- Warning! Shut down the engine before starting any work VW Transporter T4 Van (70A, 70H, 7DA, 7DH).

### CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

- 1 Open the bonnet.
- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Release the cabin filter cover clips. Remove the cabin filter housing cover.



Remove the cabin air filter housing.

5 Unplug the mass air flow sensor connector.



6 Detach the power steering reservoir.



Loosen the clamp and remove the intake air hose from the filter housing. Use water pump pliers.



Release the air filter cover clips.



9 Unscrew the filter housing fastening bolts. Use HEX No.H5.

Take off the filter lid.



Remove the filter element from the filter housing.



- Cover the air intake hose with a microfibre towel to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the system.
- Clean the air filter cover and housing.



# Replacement: air filter – VW Transporter T4 Van (70A, 70H, 7DA, 7DH). Tip:

• Before cleaning the air filter cover and housing, cover the air duct parts, mass airflow sensor (if available), throttle valve with a clean cloth.

Insert a new filter element into the filter housing. Make sure that the filter edge fits tight to the housing.



#### **AUTODOC** recommends:

- Replacement: air filter VW Transporter T4 Van (70A, 70H, 7DA, 7DH). Be sure to position the filtering element correctly. Avoid misalignment.
- Take care to only use quality filters.
- During installation, make sure to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the air filter housing.

Reinstall the air filter cover. Fasten it.

Press the air filter cover clips into place.

Attach the air intake hose to the air filter housing. Tighten the fuel filter pipe clamp.



Attach the power steering reservoir.



Plug in the mass air flow sensor conntector.



20 Install the cabin air filter housing.

Screw the filter housing fastening bolts. Use HEX No.H5.

Reinstall the cabin filter housing cover. Make sure you hear a click indicating that it is locked in place.



- Remove the fender protection cover.
- Close the hood.




