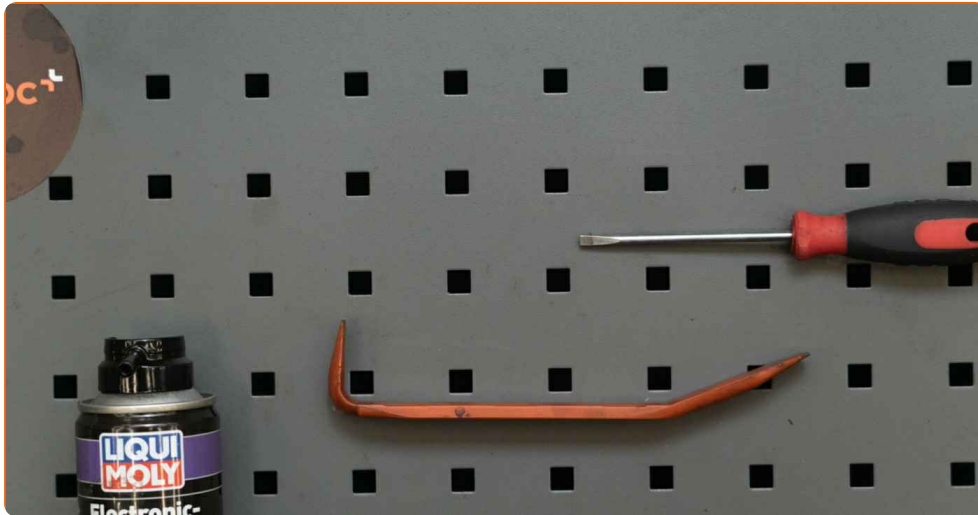

VW Transporter T5 Minibus (7HB, 7HJ, 7EB, 7EJ, 7EF, 7EG, 7HF, 7EC) 1.9 TDI, VW Transporter T5 Minibus (7HB, 7HJ, 7EB, 7EJ, 7EF, 7EG, 7HF, 7EC) 2.5 TDI, VW Transporter T5 Minibus (7HB, 7HJ, 7EB, 7EJ, 7EF, 7EG, 7HF, 7EC) 2.0, VW Transporter T5 Minibus (7HB, 7HJ, 7EB, 7EJ, 7EF, 7EG, 7HF, 7EC) 3.2 V6, VW Transporter T5 Minibus (7HB, 7HJ, 7EB, 7EJ, 7EF, 7EG, 7HF, 7EC) 2.5 TDI 4motion, VW Transporter T5 Minibus (7HB, 7HJ, 7EB, 7EJ, 7EF, 7EG, 7HF, 7EC) 3.2 V6 4motion, VW Transporter T5 Minibus (7HB, 7HJ, 7EB, 7EJ, 7EF, 7EG, 7HF, 7EC) 2.5 TDi

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

REPLACEMENT: GLASS FOR WING MIRROR – VW

- Electronic spray
- Flat Screwdriver
- Plastic trim tool
- Fender cover

Replacement: glass for wing mirror – VW Transporter T5 Minibus (7HB, 7HJ, 7EB, 7EJ, 7EF, 7EG, 7HF, 7EC). AUTODOC recommends:

- The replacement procedure is identical for the right and left side mirror glass.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: GLASS FOR WING MIRROR – VW TRANSPORTER T5 MINIBUS (7HB, 7HJ, 7EB, 7EJ, 7EF, 7EG, 7HF, 7EC). RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:

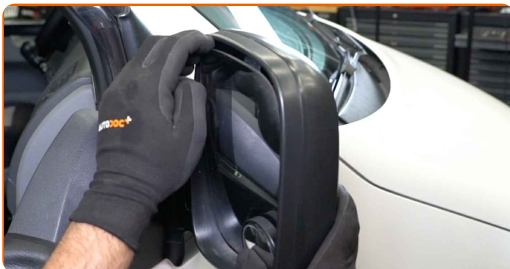

Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.



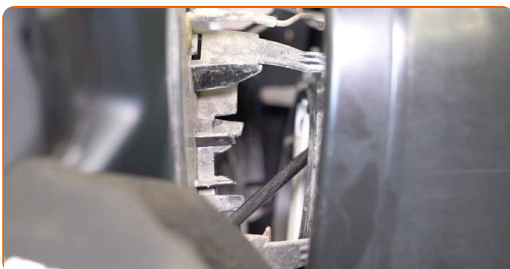

Tilt the mirror glass out of the housing.



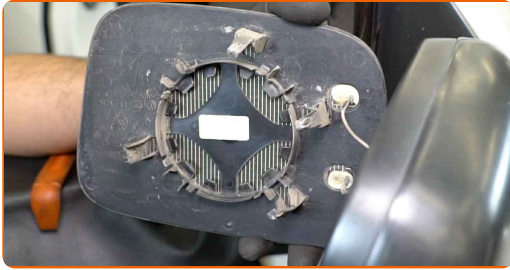

Carefully release the mirror glass from its attachment. Use a plastic trim tool. Use a flat screwdriver.

Remove the mirror glass.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: glass for wing mirror – VW Transporter T5 Minibus (7HB, 7HJ, 7EB, 7EJ, 7EF, 7EG, 7HF, 7EC). Do not use excessive force when removing the part as this may damage it.

Detach the mirror heating connectors.



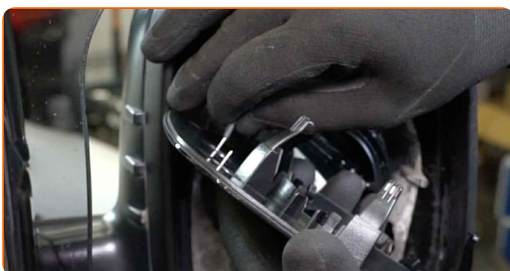

Treat the mirror heating connectors. Use dielectric grease.

Attach the mirror heating connectors.

Install the new mirror glass. Make sure you hear a click indicating that it is locked in place.

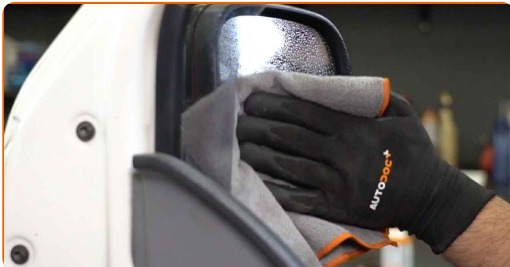


AUTODOC recommends:

- Replacement: glass for wing mirror – VW Transporter T5 Minibus (7HB, 7HJ, 7EB, 7EJ, 7EF, 7EG, 7HF, 7EC). To avoid damaging the part during installation, do not use excessive force.
- Make sure the mirror glass is positioned correctly. It should be aligned with the locking tabs on the housing.

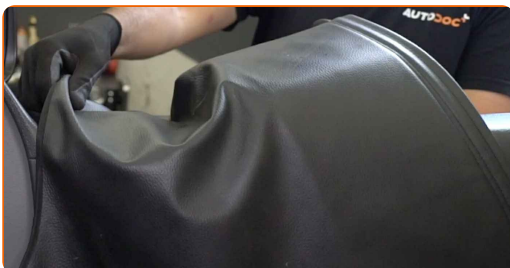

Clean the mirror glass.



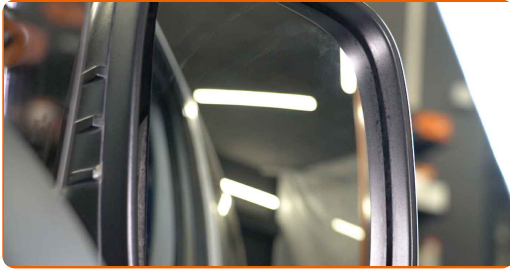

Remove the fender protection cover.

Switch on the ignition. This is necessary in order to make sure that the component operates properly.

Switch off the ignition.
