

#### Replacement: air filter – Nissan X Trail T30. AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Follow the terms, recommendations and requirements of the part operation provided by the manufacturer.
- Please note: all work on the car Nissan X Trail T30 should be done with the engine switched off.

## CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:



Open the hood.



2

Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.





Release the air filter cover clips.

Slightly raise the cover of the air filter housing.



5

Remove the filter element from the air filter cover.



6

Cover the air intake hose with a microfibre towel to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the system.



7

Clean the air filter cover and housing.



8

Remove the microfibre towel from the air intake hose.





9

Insert a new filter element into the filter housing. Make sure that the filter edge fits tight to the housing.



### Replacement: air filter – Nissan X Trail T30. Tip:

- Check out the correct location of the filter element. Do not skew.
- Attention! Use quality filters Nissan X Trail T30.
- During installation, make sure to prevent dust and dirt from getting into the air filter housing.

Reinstall the air filter cover. Fasten it.



11

Press the air filter cover clips into place.
