** Important!**

This replacement procedure can be used for:

CITROËN C4 II (B7) 2.0 HDi / BlueHDi 150, CITROËN AX (ZA-\_) 1.0 E, CITROËN AX (ZA-\_) 1.0, CITROËN AX (ZA-\_) 1.1, CITROËN AX (ZA-\_) 1.3 Sport, CITROËN AX (ZA-\_) 1.4, CITROËN AX (ZA-\_) 1.4 D, CITROËN Visa Hatchback 16 GTI, CITROËN Visa Hatchback 17 D, CITROËN BX (XB-\_) 1.4 E, CITROËN BX (XB-\_) 1.6, CITROËN BX (XB-\_) 1.9, CITROËN BX (XB-\_) 1.9 E, CITROËN BX (XB-\_) 1.9 GTi, CITROËN BX (XB-\_) 1.9 GTi 16V, (+ 388)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

REPLACEMENT: ENGINE OIL AND FILTER – CITROEN XSARA PICASSO. LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Wire brush
- All-purpose cleaning spray
- Oil filter cup socket 74/76-15F
- Drive socket # 21
- Ratchet wrench
- Torque wrench
- Oil drain pan
- Funnel
- Fender cover

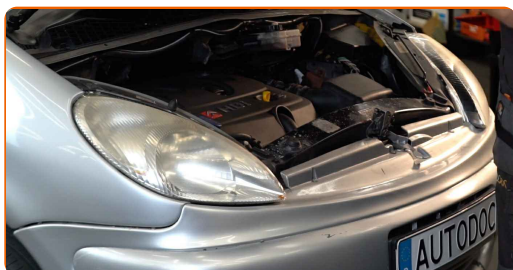
**BUY TOOLS**

Replacement: engine oil and filter – Citroen Xsara Picasso. Tip from AUTODOC:

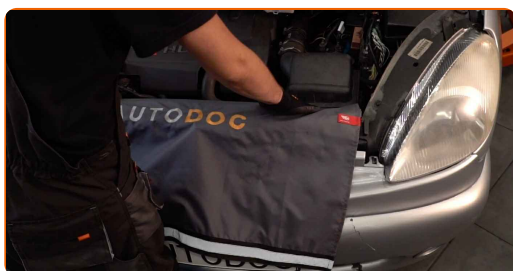
- Replace the oil filter every time when changing motor oil.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.
- Wear gloves to prevent contact with hot liquid.

**REPLACEMENT: ENGINE OIL AND FILTER – CITROEN XSARA PICASSO. RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:**

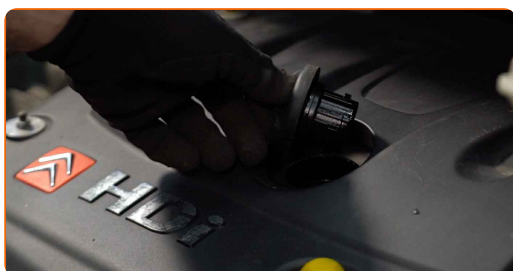
**1** Open the hood.



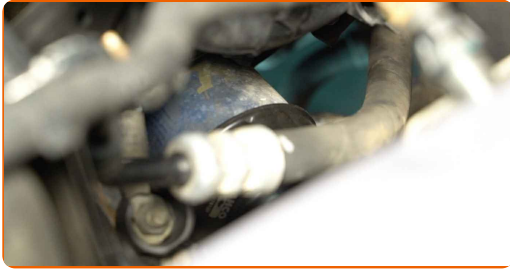
**2** Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.



**3** Unscrew the oil filler plug.



**4** Unscrew the oil filter. Use the 74/76-15F socket.



**5** Prepare a container for the old oil filter. Put the old oil filter in the container.

Replacement: engine oil and filter – Citroen Xsara Picasso. AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Move up the container. The oil starts to drain out of the drainage hole immediately after you have removed the oil filter.

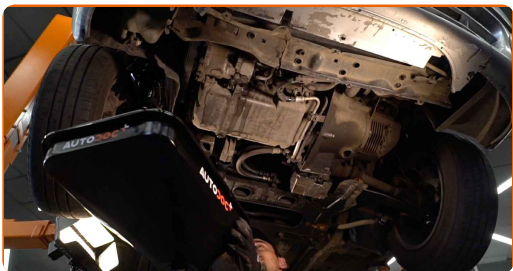
**6** Lift the car using a jack or place it over an inspection pit.



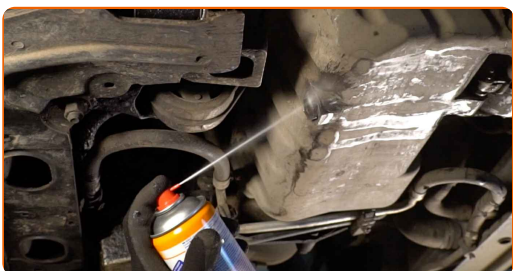
Replacement: engine oil and filter – Citroen Xsara Picasso. AUTODOC recommends:

- The vehicle must be on even keel, and if it is at an angle, the drain plug must be at the lowest point.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

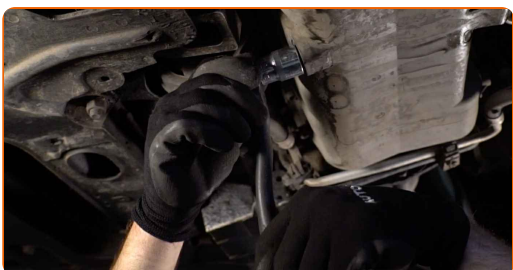
**7** Put a waste oil container with at least 5 l capacity under the drainage hole.



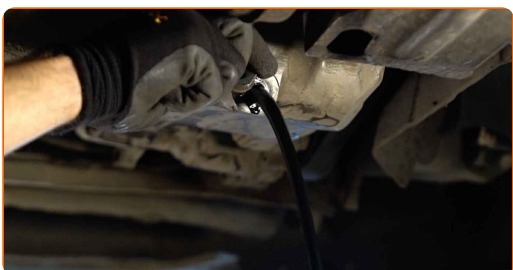
**8** Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use a wire brush. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



**9** Unscrew the drain plug. Use a drive socket #21. Use a ratchet wrench.



**10** Drain the used oil.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – Citroen Xsara Picasso. Professionals recommend:

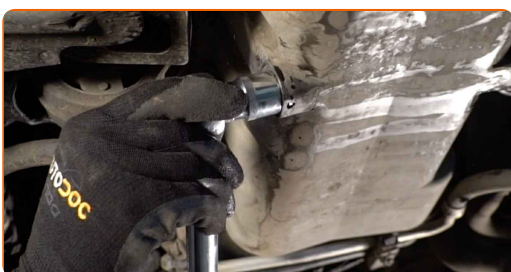
- Caution! The oil may be hot.

**11** Wait until the oil has completely drained from the drainage hole.

**12** Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole.



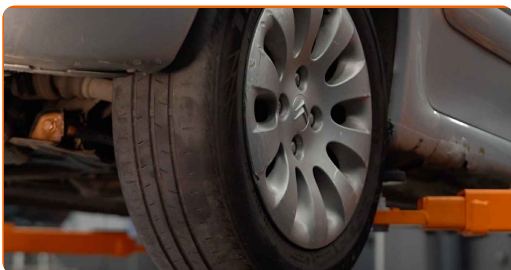
**13** Screw in the new drainage plug and tighten it. Use a drive socket #21. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 34 Nm torque.



**14** Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



**15** Lower the car.

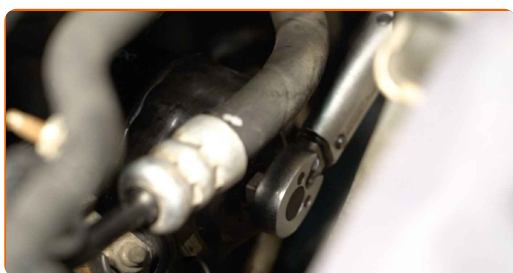




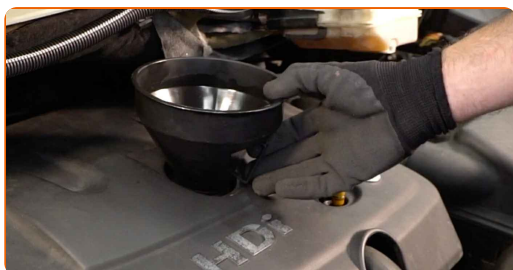
**16** Lubricate the rubber seal of the new filter with a little amount of fresh oil.



**17** Screw the new filter into its place. Use the 74/76-15F socket. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 25 Nm torque.



**18** Remove the oil filler cap. Insert the funnel.



**19** Pour oil into the engine through the filler. Required amount of oil: 4.5 L.



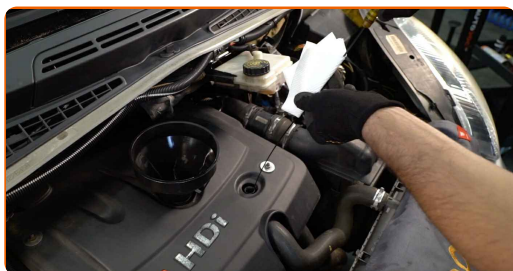
**Replacement: engine oil and filter – Citroen Xsara Picasso. Tip:**

- Use the oil recommended by the manufacturer.

Check the oil level using the dipstick. Top up oil if necessary.



Please note!

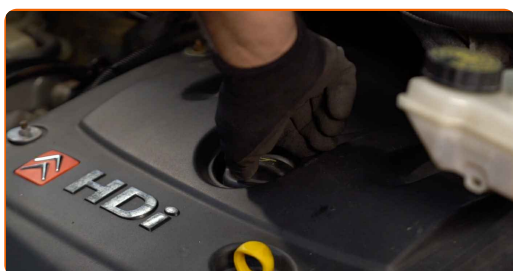
- The oil level should be between the Min and Max marks.

Install the oil filler cap.

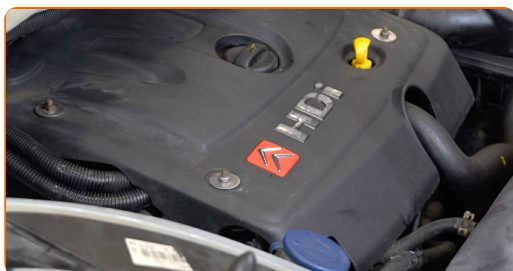

Tighten the oil filler cap.

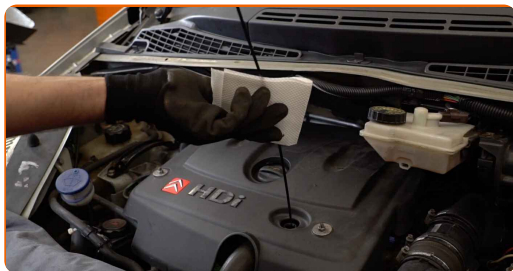

Run the engine for a few minutes. After the oil pressure warning light goes out, stop the engine.



**24** Check the oil level 5 minutes after the stop of the engine operation using a dipstick and add oil if necessary.



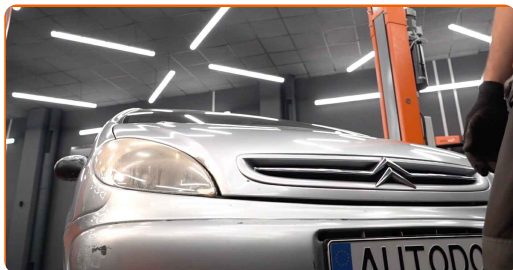
Replacement: engine oil and filter – Citroen Xsara Picasso. Tip from AUTODOC:

- The oil level should be between the Min and Max marks.
- Make sure that the oil filler cap is properly tightened.
- Check the threaded plug of the drainage hole and the oil filter seal for tightness. If necessary, carefully tighten them up.

**25** Remove the fender protection cover.



**26** Close the hood.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – Citroen Xsara Picasso. Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Note that oil pressure warning light, which indicates insufficient pressure in the lubrication system, may be on for a longer time than usual. After a few seconds, the oil will fill all the channels, and the light will go out.
- To protect the environment from pollution, be sure to dispose of the used filters at special collection points.
