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How to change front suspension strut on **Toyota Yaris P1** – replacement guide

This replacement procedure can be used for: TOYOTA Yaris Hatchback ($_{\rm P1}$) 1.0 (SCP10 $_{\rm NCP13}$), TOYOTA Yaris Hatchback ($_{\rm P1}$) 1.5 (NCP13 $_{\rm NCP13}$), TOYOTA Yaris Hatchback ($_{\rm P1}$) 1.4 D-4D (NLP10 $_{\rm NCP13}$), TOYOTA Yaris Hatchback ($_{\rm P1}$) 1.3 (SCP12 $_{\rm NCP13}$)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.


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REPLACEMENT: SUSPENSION STRUT – TOYOTA YARIS P1. LIST OF THE TOOLS YOU'LL NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- Brake cleaner
- Copper grease
- Combination spanner #12
- Combination spanner #19
- Drive socket # 14
- Drive socket # 17

- Drive socket # 19
- Wheel impact socket #21
- Ratchet wrench
- Torque wrench
- Flat Screwdriver
- Hydraulic strut spring compressor
- Fender cover
- Wheel chock

BUY TOOLS

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Replacement: suspension strut – Toyota Yaris P1. AUTODOC recommends:

- Both shock struts of the front suspension should be replaced simultaneously.
- The replacement procedure is identical for the left and right shock struts of the front suspension.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

REPLACEMENT: SUSPENSION STRUT – TOYOTA YARIS P1. USE THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE:

1 Secure the wheels with chocks.



Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #21.



Raise the front of the car and secure on supports.

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4 Unscrew the wheel bolts.



Replacement: suspension strut – Toyota Yaris P1. Tip:

- To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when unscrewing the bolts.
- Remove the wheel.



- Clean the fastener of the bracket that connects the brake hose to the shock strut. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.
- Unscrew the brake hose fastening bracket from the shock strut. Use a drive socket #14. Use a ratchet wrench.



Remove the bracket from the shock absorber strut.

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Clean the fasteners connecting the shock strut to the steering knuckle. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



Unscrew the lower fastener connecting the shock strut to the steering knuckle. Use a combination spanner #19. Use a drive socket #19. Use a ratchet wrench.



- 11 Remove the fastening bolts.
- Disconnect the steering knuckle from the shock absorber strut.



- 13 Lower the car.
- 14 Open the bonnet.



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- Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.
- Clean the fasteners of the shock strut upper mount. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.
- Loosen the upper fastener of the shock strut mount. Use a combination spanner #12.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Important! Hold the suspension strut while unscrewing the fastening bolts.

- 18 Remove the suspension strut.



Set the shock absorber strut on the spring compressor tool.



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Replacement: suspension strut – Toyota Yaris P1. AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Note that when using a spring compressor, spring coils need to be securely gripped, compressing the spring on the opposite sides.
- Ensure the correct position of the spring in the retainer.
- Make sure that the spring coils tightly entered the lock handles.

20 Compress the spring.

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Remove the protective cap from the shock absorber strut mount. Use a flat screwdriver.



Treat the shock strut rod. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



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Remove the strut piston rod nut. Use a drive socket #17. Use a ratchet wrench.



Remove the top strut mount. Use a flat screwdriver.



- Release the coil spring.
- Remove the spring.
- Remove the shock absorber dust cap and the bump stop.



AUTODOC recommends:

• Replacement: suspension strut – Toyota Yaris P1. Carefully inspect the mount, the boot, and the bump stop of the shock absorber. Replace if necessary.

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Remove the old shock absorber from the hydraulic coil spring compressor.



Replacement: suspension strut – Toyota Yaris P1. Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Before installing a new shock absorber you should pump it manually 3-5 times.
- Install the new shock absorber on the hydraulic coil spring compressor.



- Install the dust sleeve and the bump stop on the new shock absorber.
- Install the spring on the shock absorber.



Compress the spring.

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Install the upper strut mount and the strut mount bearing.



Tighten the shock strut piston rod nut. Use a drive socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 33 Nm torque.



Replacement: suspension strut – Toyota Yaris P1. Professionals recommend:

• Check to make sure the spring is positioned correctly. Avoid its misalignment.

Treat the shock strut rod. Use copper grease.

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Install the protective cap onto the shock absorber strut mount.



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- Decompress the spring.
- Remove the assembled shock strut.



Clean the mounting seats of the shock strut. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



Install the shock strut into the wheel arch.



Screw the top fastening of the shock strut mount.



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AUTODOC recommends:

- Toyota Yaris P1 To avoid injury, hold the suspension strut while screwing in the fastening bolts.
- Tighten the upper fastener of the shock absorber strut mount. Use a combination spanner #12. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 35 Nm torque.



- Treat the fasteners of the shock strut mount. Use copper grease.
- Remove the fender protection cover. Close the hood.



- Raise the front of the car and secure on supports.
- Fix the shock absorber strut on the steering knuckle.
- Install the fastening bolts.

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Tighten the lower fasteners connecting the shock strut to the steering knuckle. Use a combination spanner #19. Use a drive socket #19. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 132 Nm torque.



- Treat the shock strut fasteners. Use copper grease.
- Install the bracket onto the shock absorber strut. Tighten the brake hose fastening bracket to the shock strut. Use a drive socket #14. Use a ratchet wrench.



Treat the surface where the brake disc contacts the wheel rim. Use copper grease.



Clean the brake disk surface. Use a brake cleaner.



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Replacement: suspension strut – Toyota Yaris P1. AUTODOC recommends:

• After applying the spray, wait a few minutes.

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Install the wheel.



Replacement: suspension strut – Toyota Yaris P1. AUTODOC experts recommend:

• To avoid injury, hold up the wheel when screwing in the fastening bolts.

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Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #21.



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Lower the car and working in a cross order, tighten the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #21. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 103 Nm torque.



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Remove the jacks and chocks.



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
